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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, fruits, and beef, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, shell eggs, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 12 percent from July 1984 but were 16 percent more than the July 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 22 percent during the month but were 26 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 49 percent from last month but were 63 percent above the 1983 holdings.

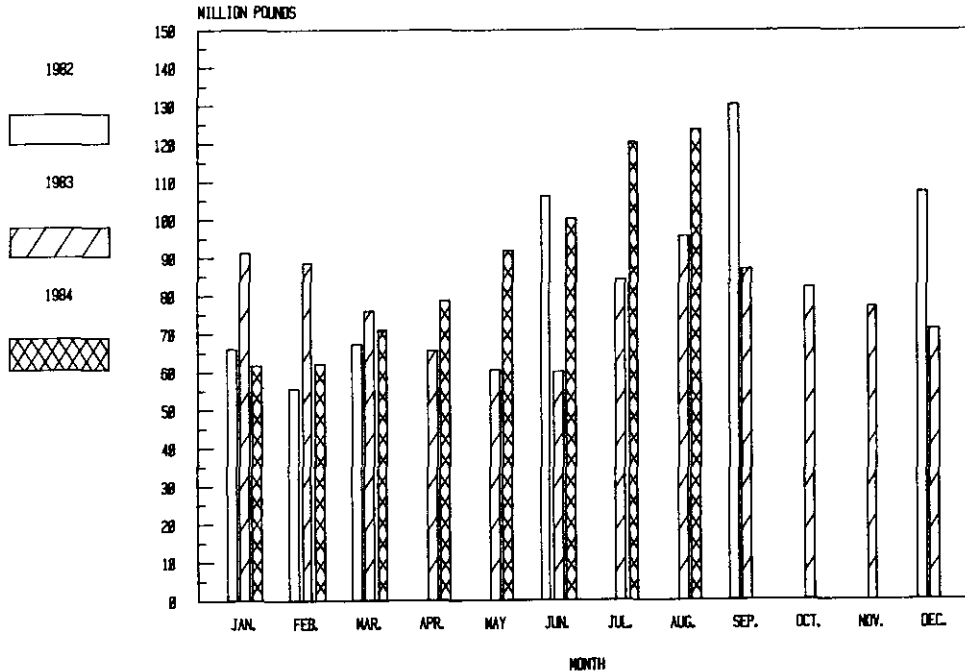

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 13 percent from July 1984 but were 11 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 3 percent during the month but were 2 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 18 percent from last month but down 15 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 3 points above last month but 3 points below last year.
