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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30, 1984 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, beef, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from August 1984 and were 20 percent more than the September 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 5 percent during the month but were 22 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 48 percent from last month but were 44 percent above the 1983 holdings.

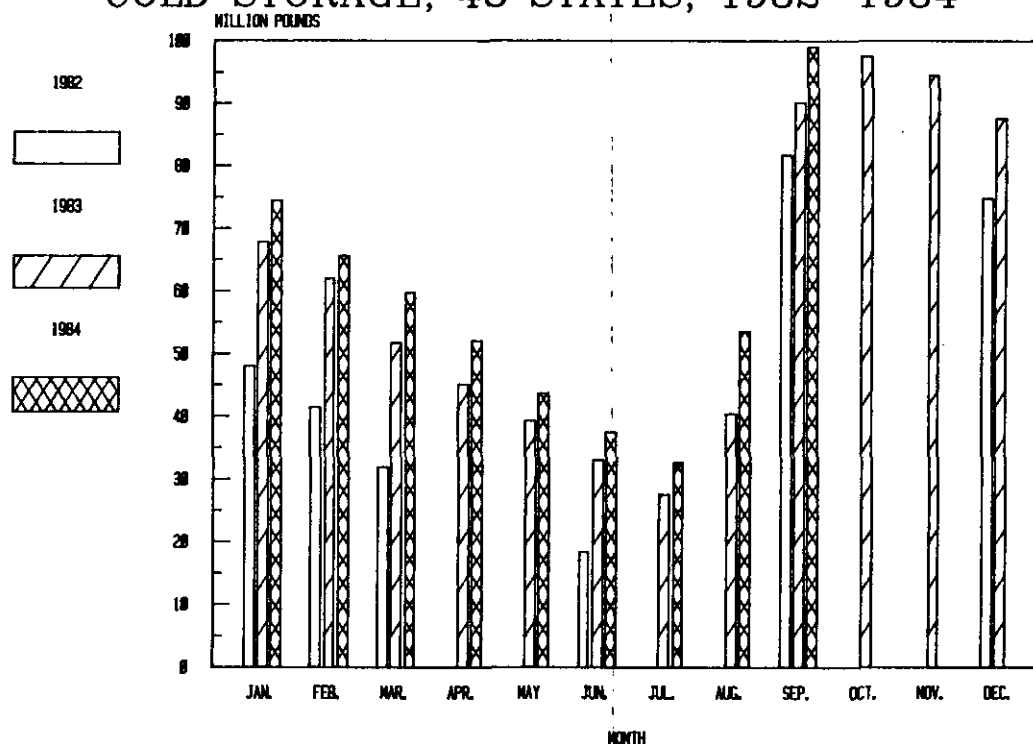

Data for this report are collected from public and private refrigerated warehouses storing commodities for 30 days or more. Stocks in space owned or leased by the Armed Forces are excluded. Food stocks held under bond are included in the storage data.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 10 percent from August 1984 but were 9 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 7 percent during the month and were 8 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 18 percent from last month but down 9 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was 58 percent of capacity, 2 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 68 percent, was 1 point above last month but 5 points below last year.
