COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, OCTOBER 31, 1984

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on October 31, 1984 were greater than year earlier levels for frozen eggs, beef, pork, fruits, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, nuts, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 3 percent from September 1984 and were 16 percent more than the October 1983 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month and were 13 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 5 percent from last month and were 17 percent above 1983

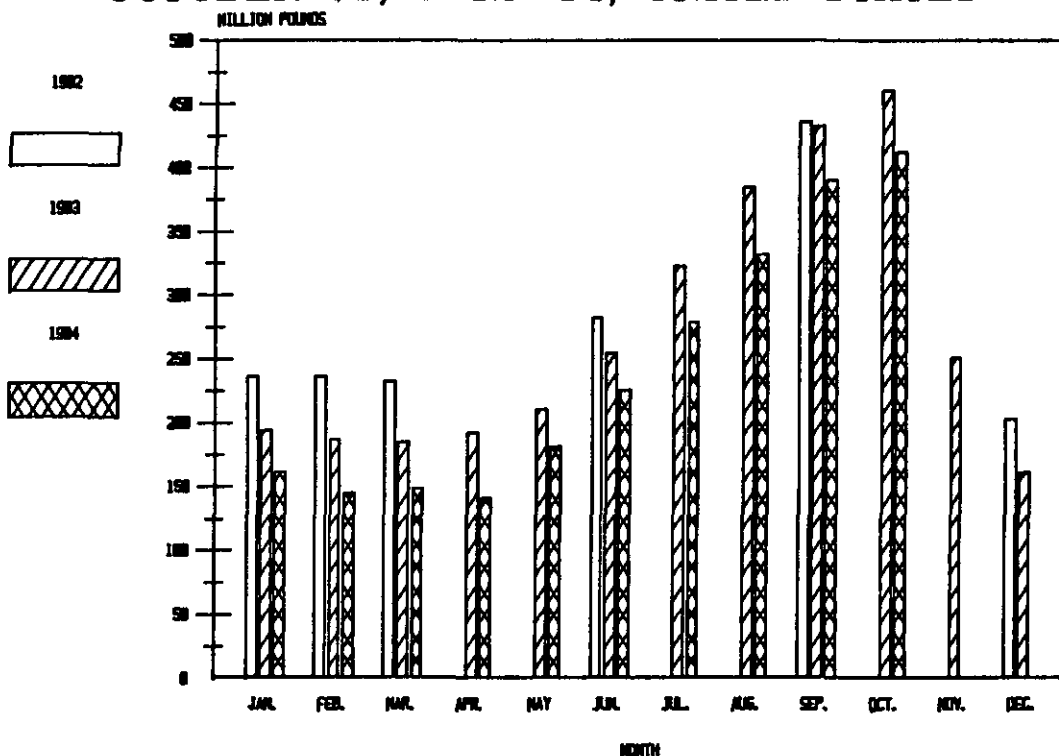

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 4 percent from September 1984 but were 9 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 2 percent during the month but were 1 percent below 1983. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 5 percent from last month but down 11 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 3 points above last month but 3 points below last year.
