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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31 were greater than year earlier levels for chickens, frozen eggs, potatoes, beef, juice concentrates, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, vegetables, and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers increased 6 percent from December 1984 and were 7 percent more than the January 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month but were 1 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 6 percent from last month and were 25 percent below the January 1984 holdings.

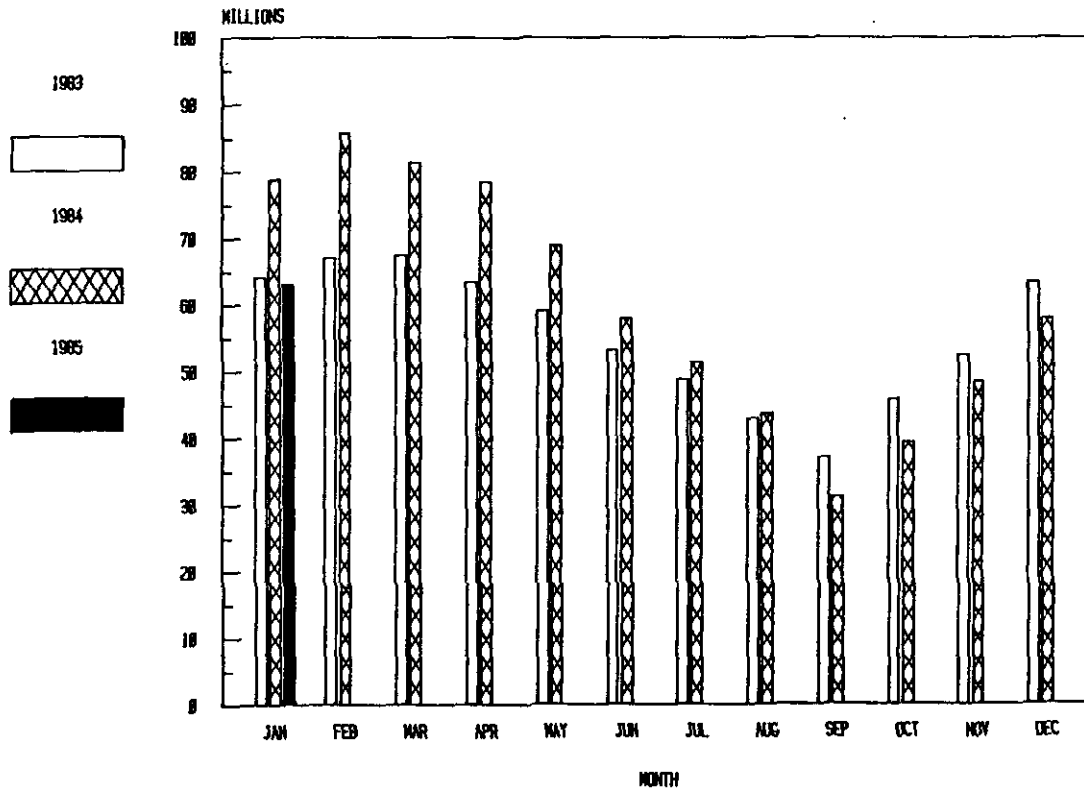

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 5 percent from December 1984 and were 2 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 11 percent during the month and were 40 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were unchanged from last month but down 22 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 2 points below last month and 2 points below last year.
