COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31 were greater than year earlier levels for chickens, potatoes, frozen eggs, juice concentrates, fruits and vegetables, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, nuts and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from April 1985 but were 4 percent less than 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 11 percent during the month but were 6 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 14 percent from last month but were 25 percent below 1984.

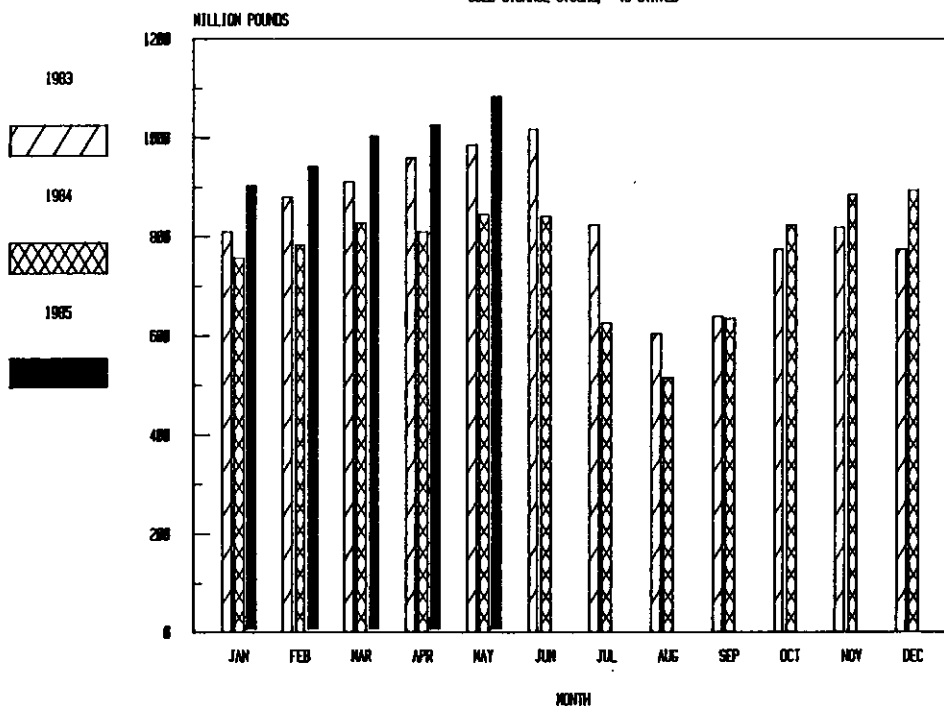

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 3 percent from April 1985 and were 14 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 6 percent during the month but were 39 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 12 percent from last month and down 3 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 65 percent was the same as last month but 2 points above last year.
