## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30, were greater than year earlier levels for chickens, potatoes, vegetables, fruits, juice concentrates, and turkeys, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, nuts, dried and evaporated fruits, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from May 1985 and were 4 percent less than the 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 7 percent during the month and were 6 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 9 percent from last month and were 24 percent below the 1984 holdings.

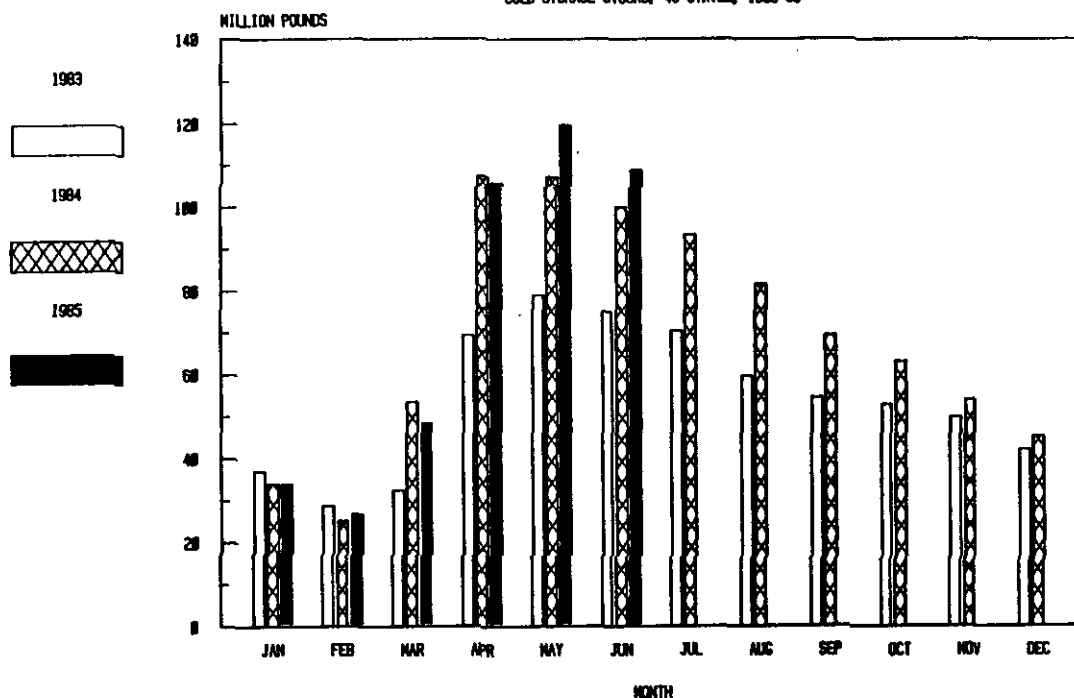

## FROZEN SPINACH IN COLD STORAGE

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 20 percent from May 1985 and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 6 percent during the month and were 42 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 33 percent from last month and up 7 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 66 percent, was 1 point above last month and 3 points above last year.
