COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31, were greater than year earlier levels for chickens, potatoes, juice concentrates, vegetables, fruits, turkeys, beef and frozen eggs according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, fruits, vegetables, dried and evaporated fruits, and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers declined 2 percent from June 1985 but were 4 percent more than the July 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 11 percent during the month but were unchanged from the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 30 percent from last month and were 28 percent below the 1984 holdings.

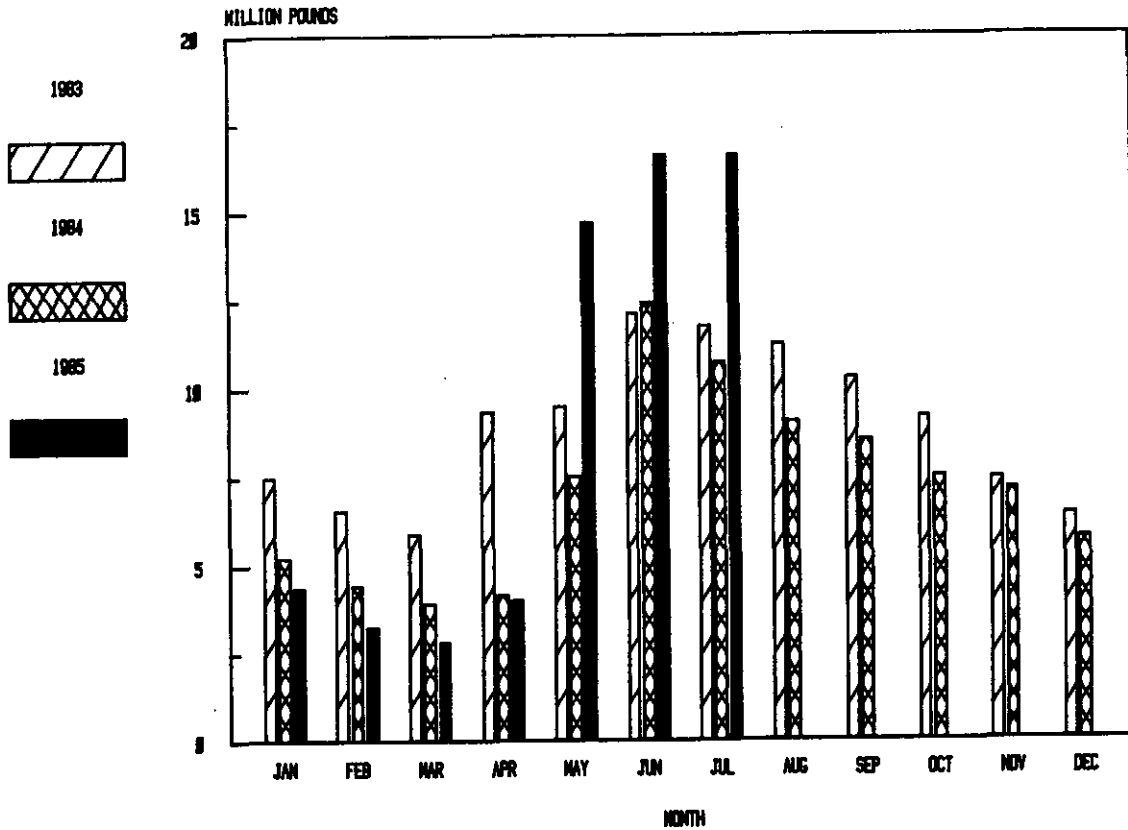

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 17 percent from June 1985 and were 18 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month and were 36 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 25 percent from last month and up 9 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 63 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 1 point above last month and 3 points above last year.
