COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31, were greater than year earlier levels for potatoes, chickens, juice concentrates, turkeys, frozen eggs, vegetables, pork, beef, and fruits according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, fresh fruits, and dried evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 8 percent from July 1985 but were 8 percent more than the August 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 14 percent during the month but were 9 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 41 percent from last month and were 17 percent below 1984.

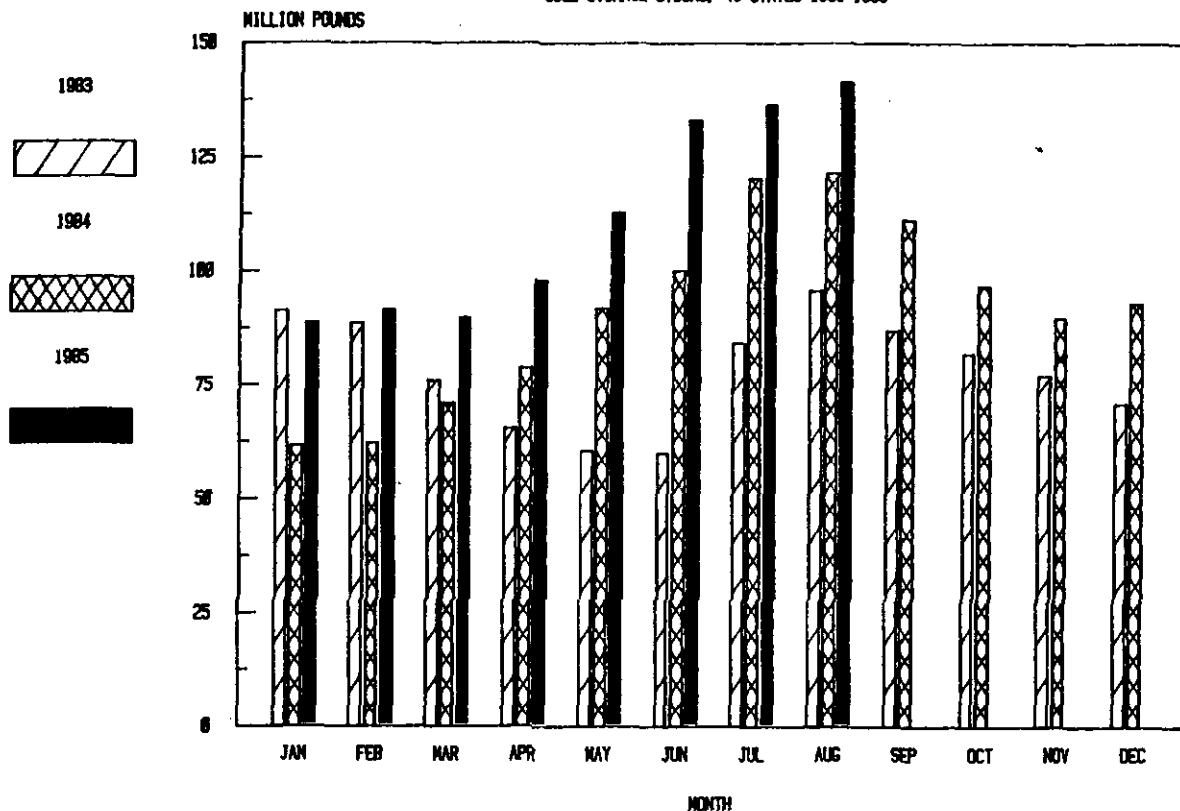

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 15 percent from July 1985 and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 4 percent during the month but were 27 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 27 percent from last month and up 16 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 70 percent was 2 points above last month and 3 points above last year.
