COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30, were greater than year earlier levels for potatoes, chickens, juices, turkeys, vegetables, fruits, eggs, and pork, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, fresh fruits, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 3 percent from August but were 2 percent more than September 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 6 percent during the month but were 9 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 41 percent from last month and were 1 percent below 1984.

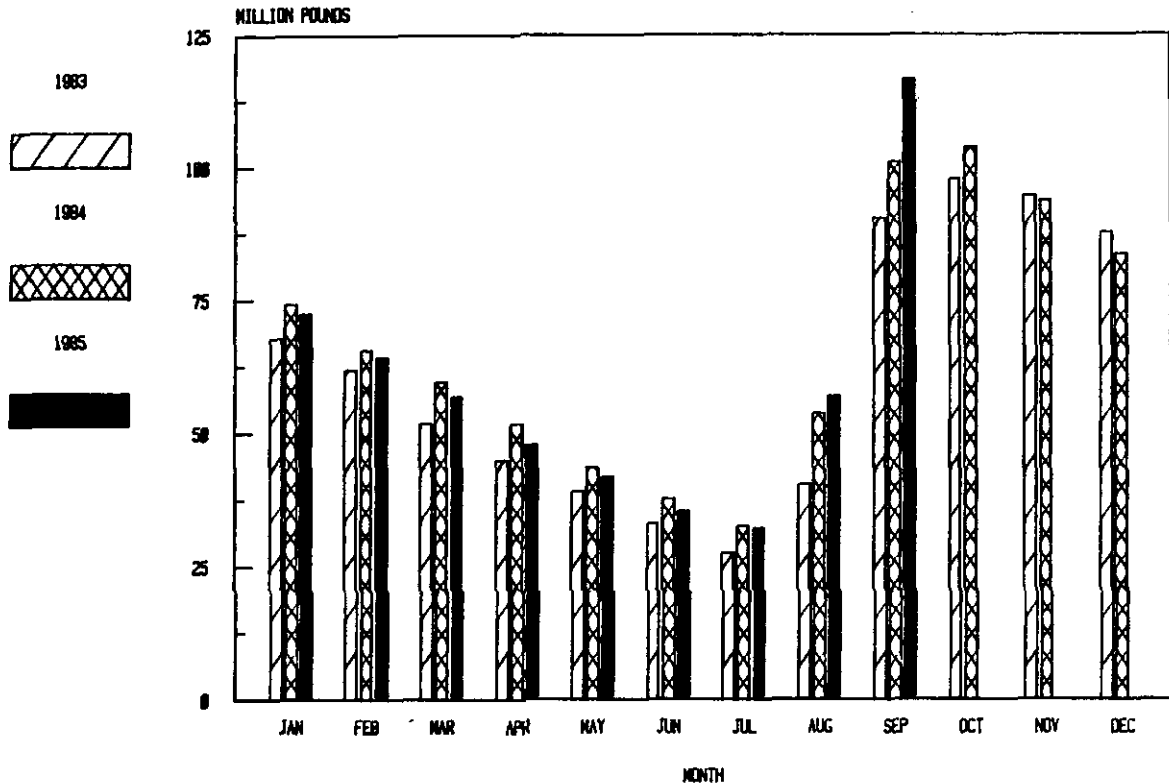

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 10 percent from August and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens were up 1 percent during the month and were 36 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 15 percent from last month and up 14 percent from last year.

Occupancy: Public cooler occupancy was at 62 percent of capacity, the same as last month. Public freezer occupancy at 73 percent was 3 points above last month and 4 points above last year.
