COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, DECEMBER 31, 1985

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, potatoes, vegetables, fruits, and juice concentrates, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, dried and evaporated fruits, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from November 1985 and were 13 percent less than the December 1984 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 13 percent during the month and were 16 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 9 percent from last month but were 10 percent below 1984.

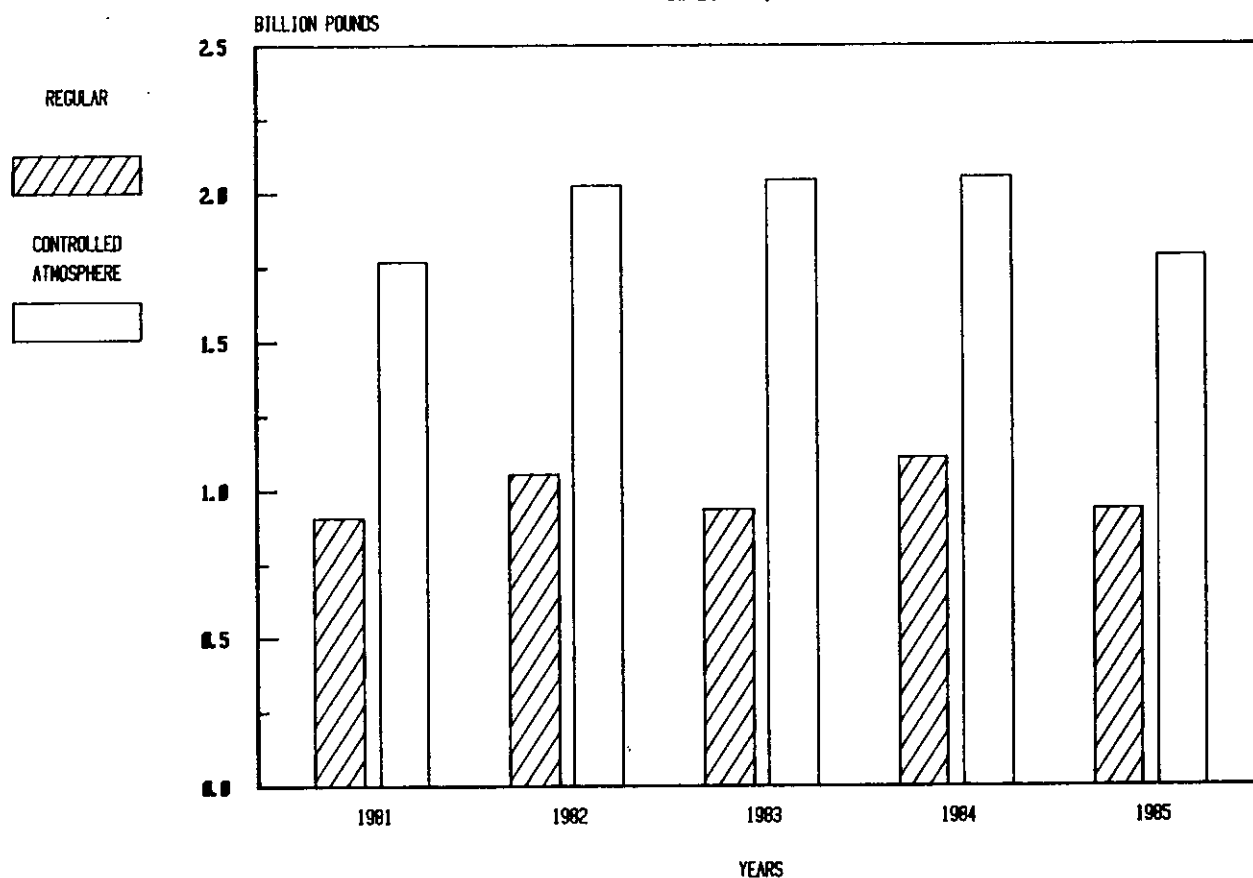

FRESH APPLES IN COLD STORAGE

DECEMBER 31, 1981-85



Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 12 percent from November 1985 but were 24 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 4 percent during the month and were 23 percent above 1984. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 25 percent from last month but up 25 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 60 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 71 percent, was 1 point below last month but 2 points above last year.
