COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1986

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, vegetables, and fruits, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from December 1985 but were 16 percent less than the January holdings a year ago. Frozen pork stocks rose 4 percent during the month but were 18 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 7 percent from last month and were 11 percent below 1985.

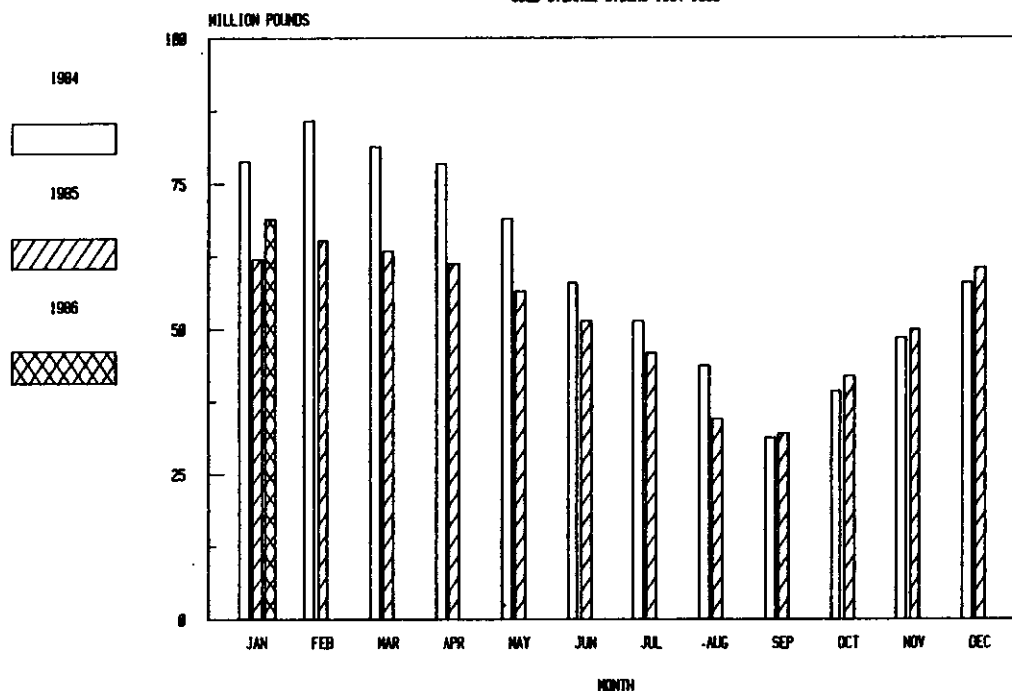

TOTAL FROZEN APPLES

COLD STORAGE STOCKS 1984-1986



Total frozen poultry supplies increased 3 percent from December 1985 and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 1 percent during the month and were 11 percent above 1985. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 5 percent from last month and up 28 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 68 percent, was 2 points below last month but 1 point above last year.
