COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1986

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, fruits, and potatoes, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Nuts were the only cooler item with stocks above the previous year.

Total red meats in freezers were unchanged from last month but were 13 percent less than the February 1985 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 3 percent during the month but were 16 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 8 percent from last month but were 1 percent below 1985.

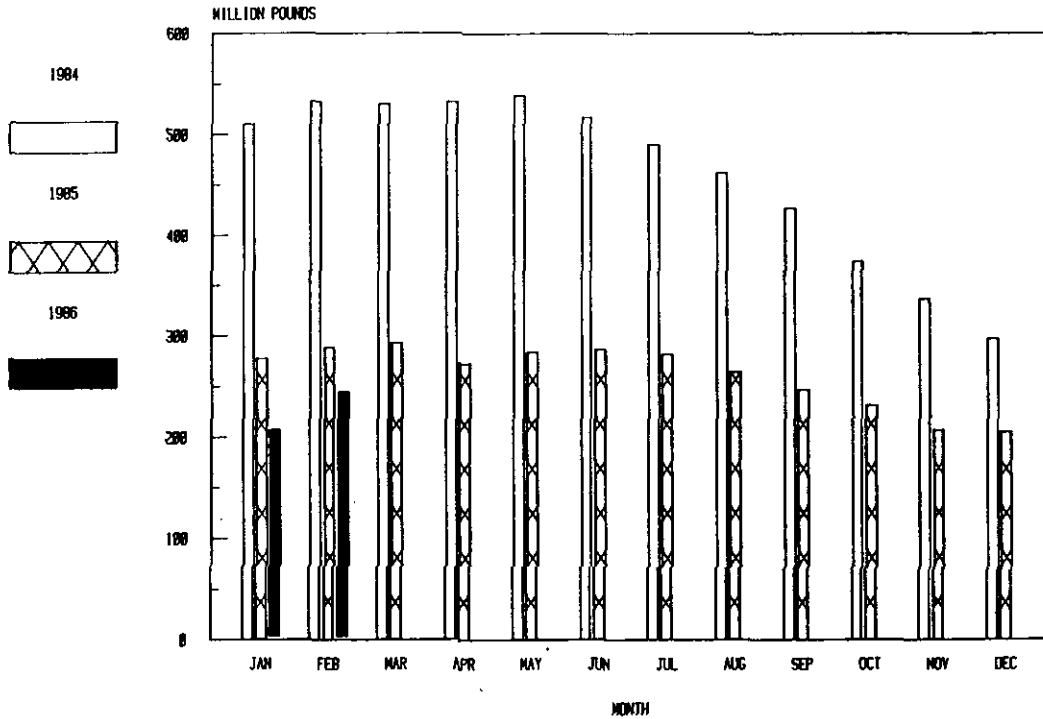

TOTAL BUTTER HOLDINGS IN COLD STORAGE

COLD STORAGE STOCKS, 48 STATES, 1984-86



Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from January 1986 and were 16 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 1 percent during the month and were 10 percent above 1985. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 1 percent from last month and up 23 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 66 percent, was 1 point below last month but the same as last year.
