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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1986

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, vegetables, fruits, and potatoes according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables and nuts.

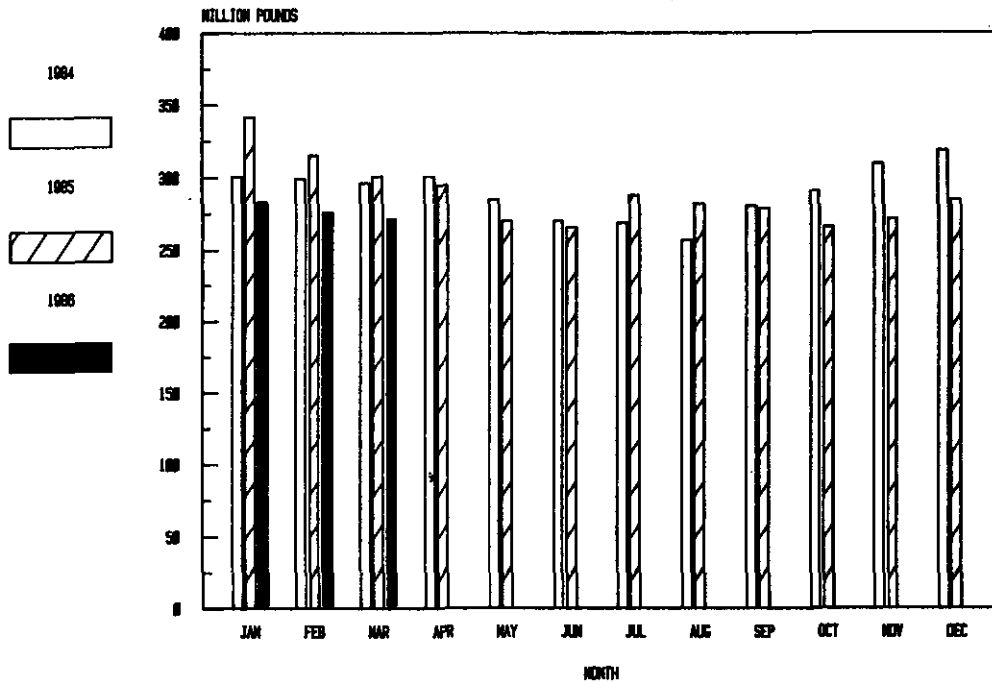

FROZEN BONELESS BEEF

Total red meats in freezers increased 1 percent from last month but were 14 percent less than March 1985 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month but were 20 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 22 percent from last month but were 9 percent below March 1985.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 1 percent from last month but were 13 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens were up 5 percent during the month and were 10 percent above 1985. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 7 percent from last month but up 14 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 61 percent of capacity, 1 point below February 28, 1986. Public freezer occupancy, at 64 percent, was 2 points below last month and 1 point below last year.
