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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1986

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, butter, chickens, vegetables, beef, potatoes, and fruits, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from April 1986 but were 14 percent less than the May 1985 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 1 percent during the month and were 31 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 3 percent from last month and were 31 percent below the 1985 holdings.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 9 percent from April 1986 and were 18 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 2 percent during the month but were 12 percent above 1985. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 21 percent from last month and up 23 percent from last year.

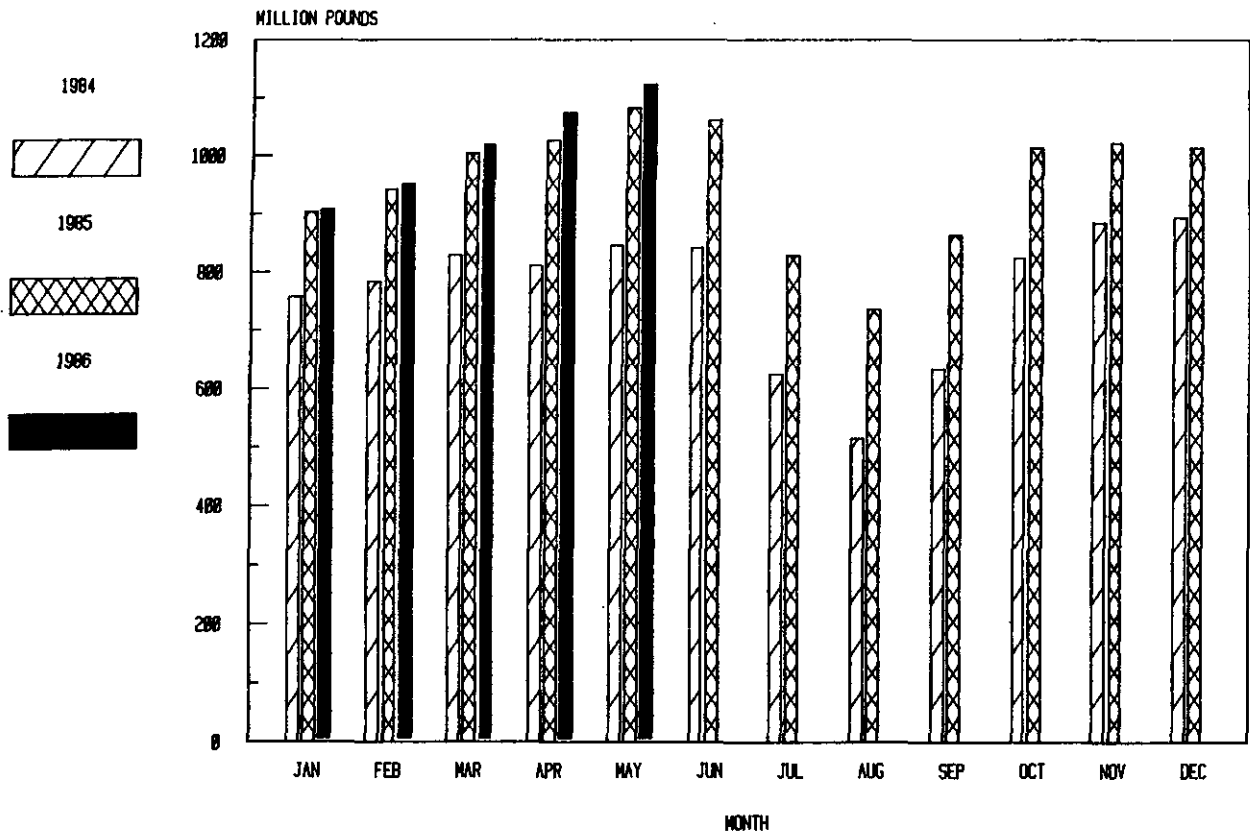
