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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1986

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys and butter, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits and shell eggs.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from August 1986 and were 17 percent less than the September 1985 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month but were 33 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 38 percent from last month and were 36 percent below the 1985 holdings.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 10 percent from August 1986 and were 10 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens were unchanged during the month but were 2 percent below 1985. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 14 percent from last month and up 15 percent from last year.

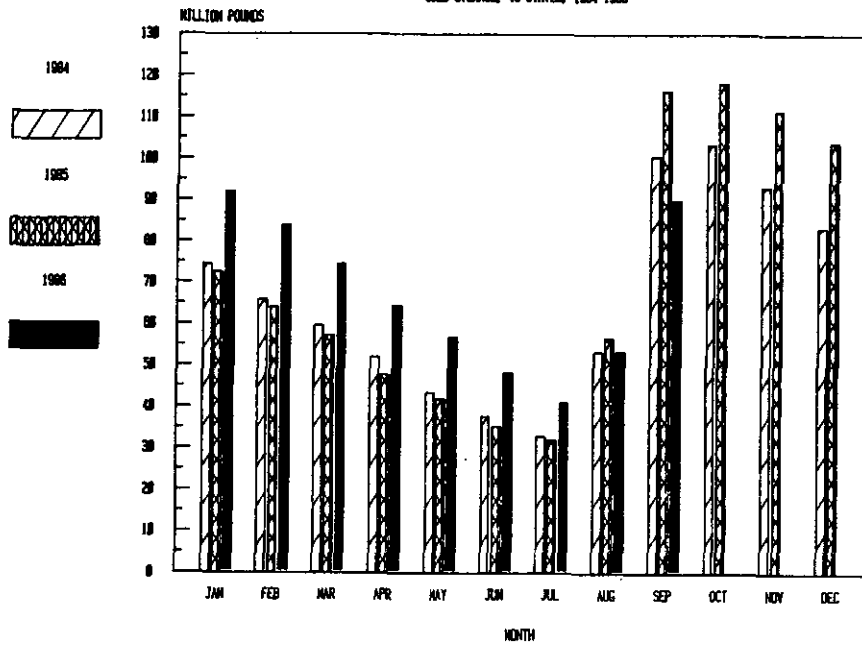

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 55 percent of capacity, 2 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 70 percent, was 2 points above last month but 3 points below last year.
