COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, frozen eggs, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from January 1987 and were 4 percent less than the February 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 5 percent during the month but were 4 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 1 percent from last month and were 33 percent below the 1986 holdings.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 5 percent from January 1987 and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 4 percent during the month and were 11 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 7 percent from last month and up 30 percent from last year.

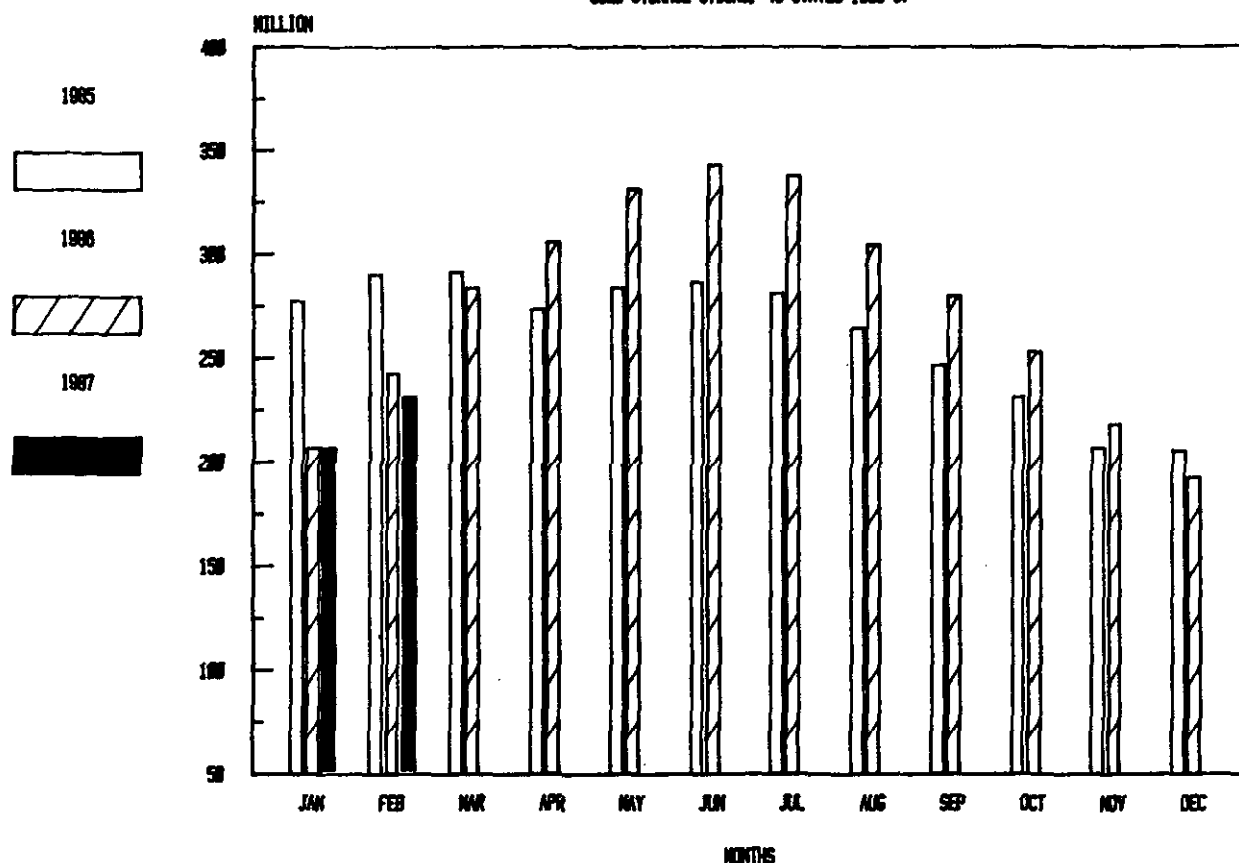

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 59 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 61 percent, was 2 points below last month and 5 points below last year.
