COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31, 1987 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, frozen eggs, chickens, and beef according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from February 1987 and were 4 percent less than the March 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 3 percent during the month and were 12 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 20 percent from last month but were 33 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 5 percent from February 1987 and were 27 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 2 percent during the month and were 7 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 8 percent from last month and up 52 percent from last year.

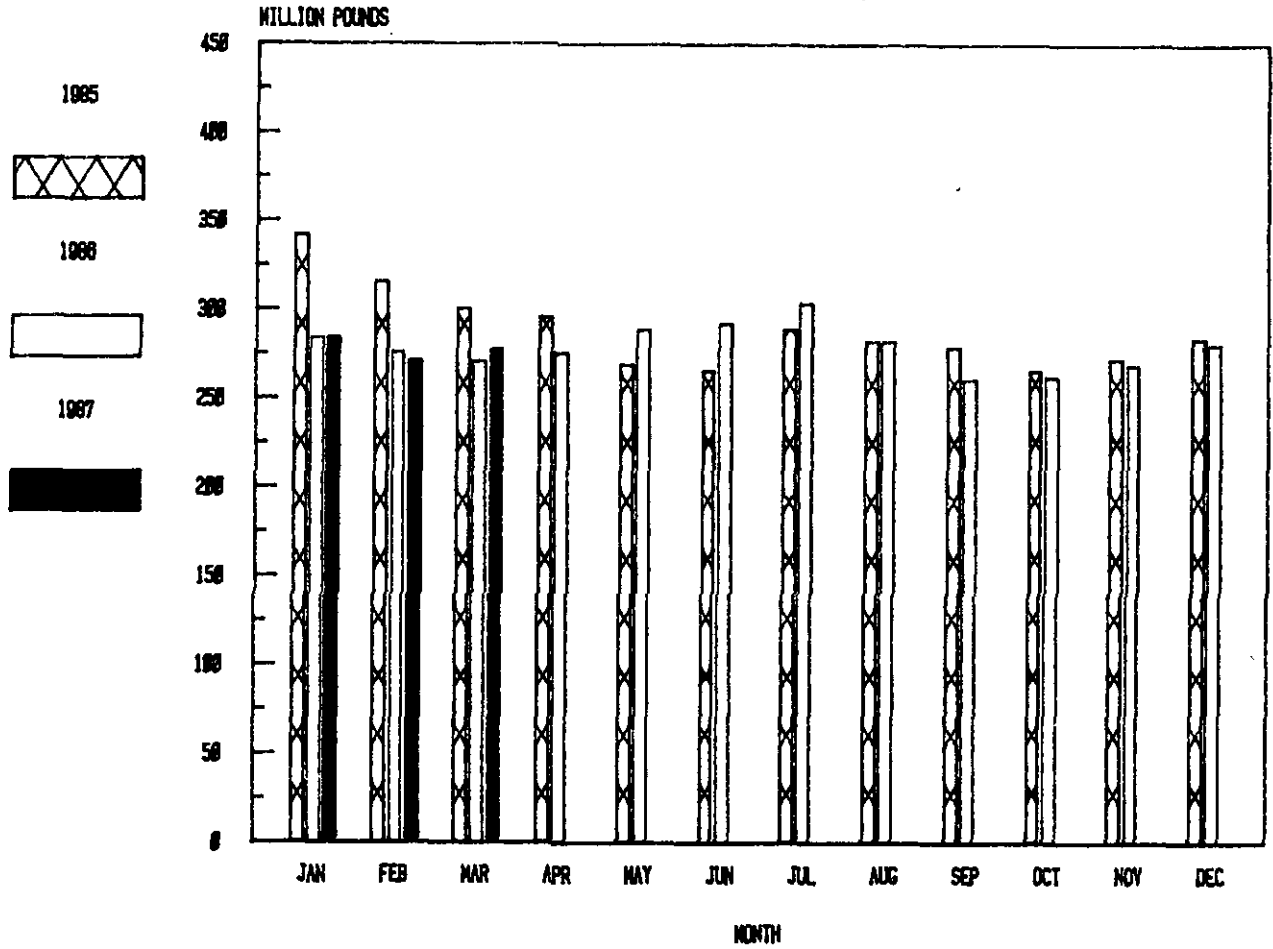

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 56 percent of capacity, 3 points below last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 62 percent, was 1 point above last month but 3 points below last year.
