COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30, 1987 were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, chickens, frozen eggs, and beef according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Total fresh fruits was the only cooler item with stocks above the previous year's level.

Total red meats in freezers declined 1 percent from March 1987 and were 10 percent less than the April 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 2 percent during the month and were 23 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 21 percent from last month but were 26 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 6 percent from March 1987 and were 19 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 3 percent during the month and were 8 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 10 percent from last month and up 32 percent from last year.

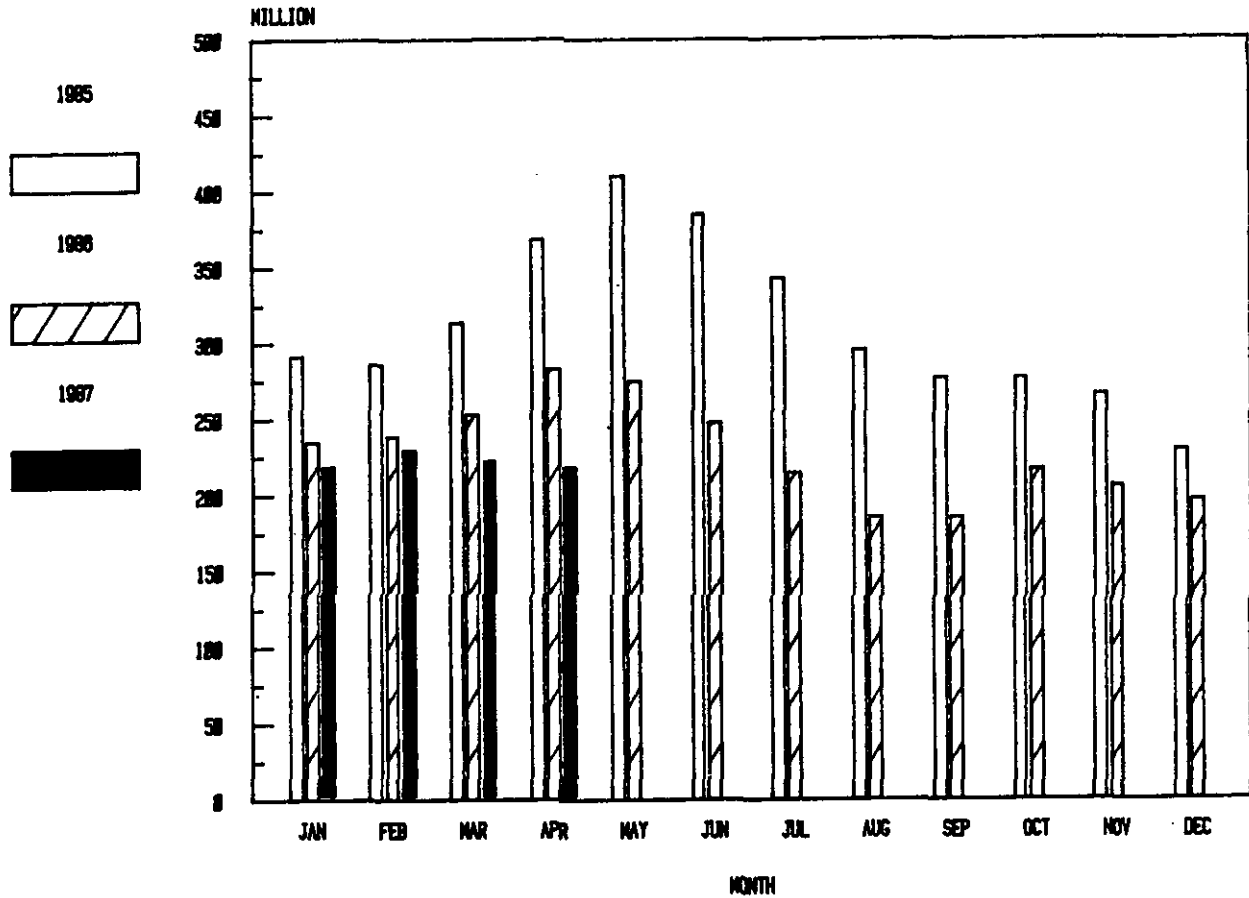

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 58 percent of capacity, 1 point above last month. Public freezer occupancy, at 62 percent, was unchanged from last month but 3 points below last year.
