COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31, 1987 were greater than year earlier levels for frozen eggs, turkeys, chickens, fruits, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Total fresh fruits was the only cooler item with stocks above the previous year's level.

Total red meats in freezers declined 6 percent from April 1987 and were 17 percent less than the May 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month but were 20 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 15 percent from last month but were 12 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 13 percent from April 1987 and were 25 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month and were 18 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 20 percent from last month and up 31 percent from last year.

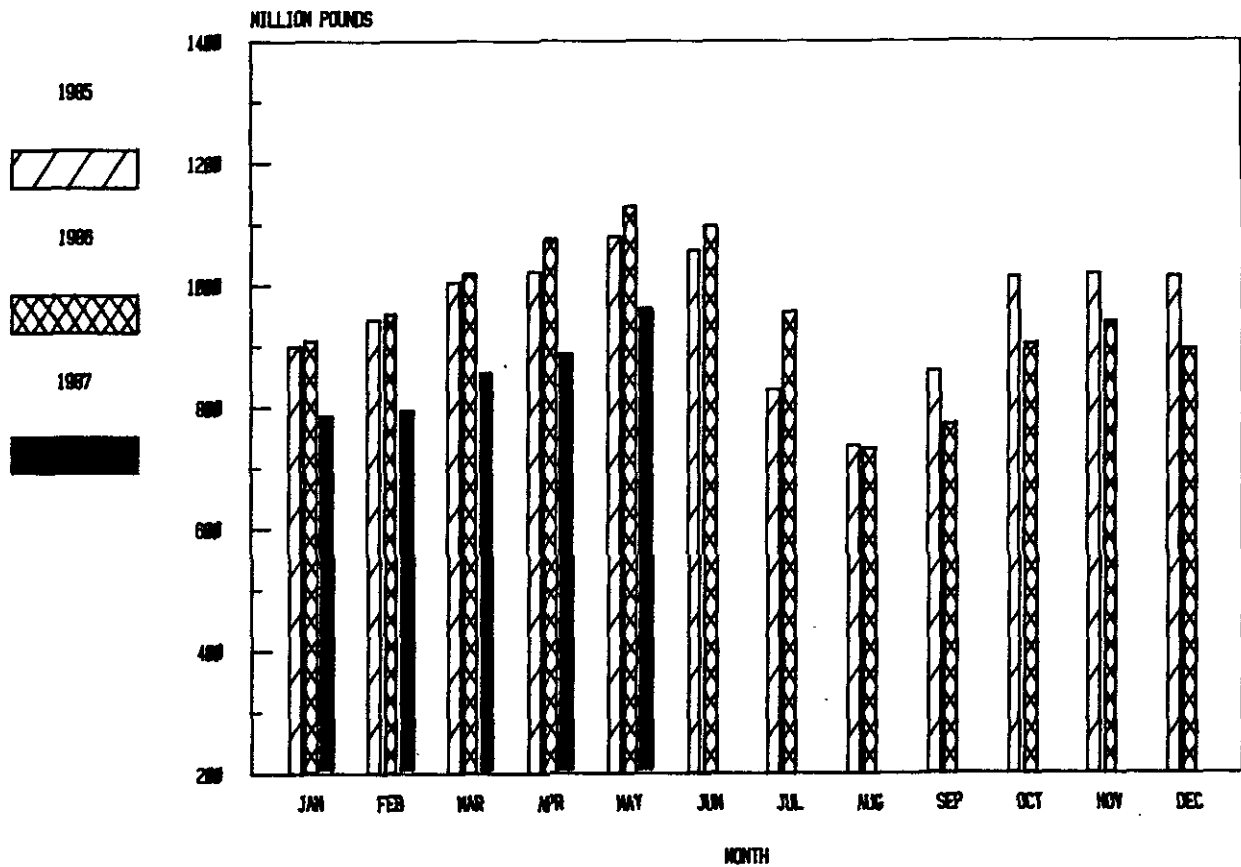
