## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31, 1987, were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, fruits, frozen eggs, chickens, vegetables, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers increased 4 percent from June 1987 but were 17 percent less than the July 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks dropped 7 percent during the month and were 19 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 40 percent from last month and were 29 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 14 percent from June 1987 and were 18 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 6 percent during the month but were 11 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 24 percent from last month and up 22 percent from last year.

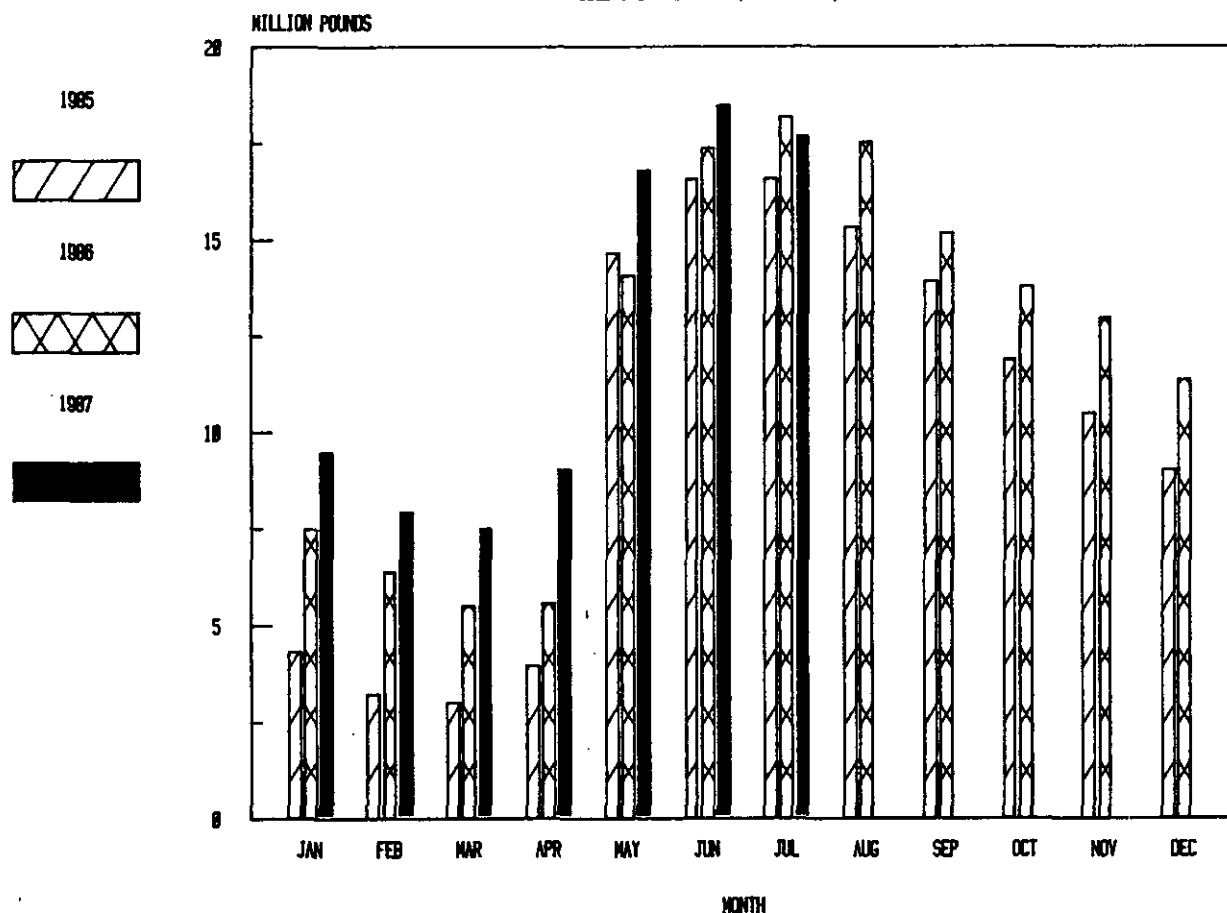
