## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31, 1987, were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, fruits, frozen eggs, vegetables, and chickens, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits, nuts, and evaporated and condensed milk. Butter stocks were at the lowest level since the late 70's and American cheese was at lowest level since 1981.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from July 31, 1987 and were 13 percent less than those on August 31, 1986. Frozen pork stocks dropped 3 percent during the month and were 5 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 34 percent from last month and were 9 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 10 percent from July 31, 1987 and were 18 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 9 percent during the month but were 3 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 18 percent from last month and up 24 percent from last year.

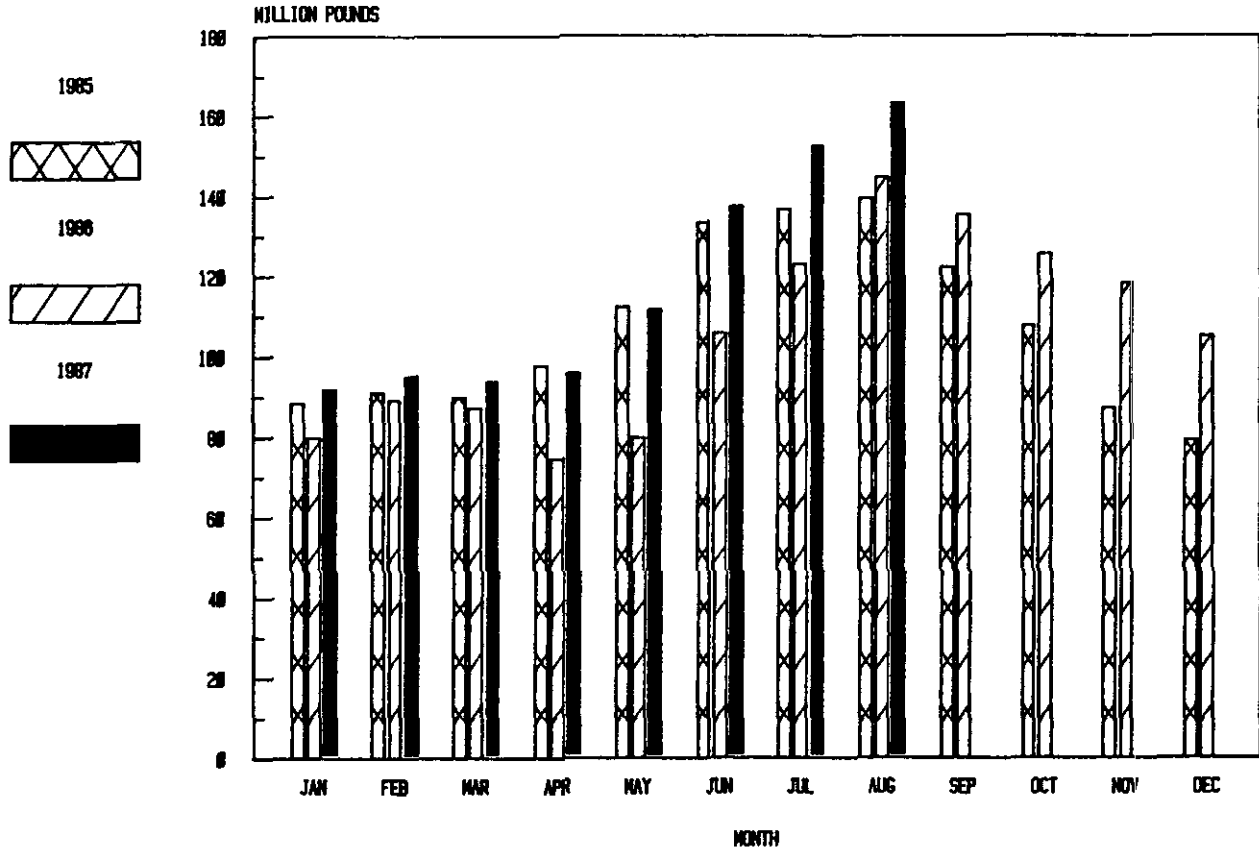
