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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1987

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30, 1987, were greater than year earlier levels for turkeys, juice concentrates, fruits, frozen eggs, vegetables, chickens, and potatoes, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included nuts, fresh fruits, shell eggs, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers increased 5 percent from August 31, 1987 but were 4 percent less than the September 30, 1986 holdings. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month but were unchanged from the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 32 percent from last month and were 1 percent below 1986.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 12 percent from August 31, 1987, and were 21 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 6 percent during the month and were 9 percent above 1986. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 15 percent from last month and up 25 percent from last year.

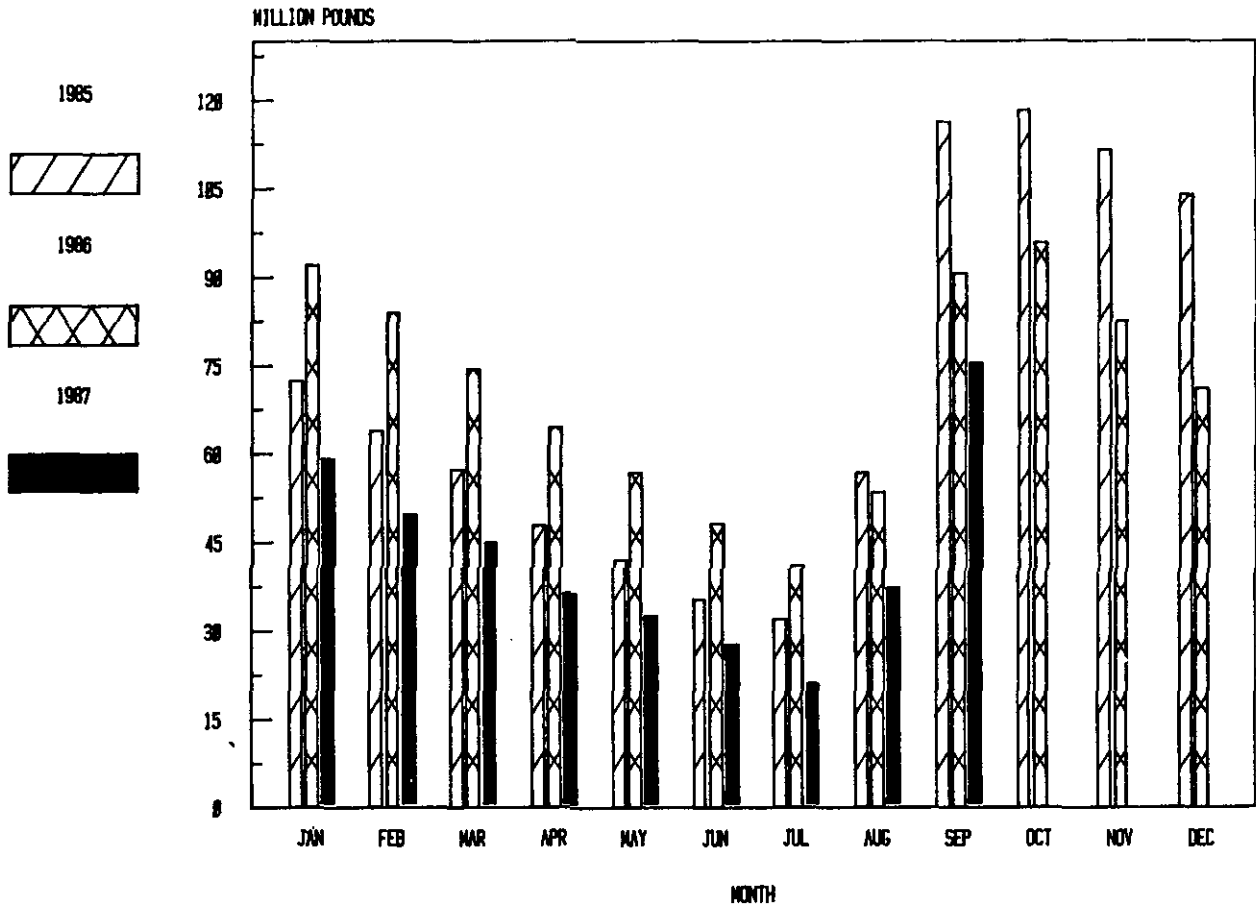

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 56 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 73 percent was 4 points above last month and 3 points above last year.
