COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1988

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31 were greater than year earlier levels for pork, butter, eggs, potatoes, juice concentrates, beef, and fruits, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included dried and evaporated fruits, evaporated and condensed milk, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from July 31 but were 27 percent more than those on August 31, 1987. Frozen pork stocks dropped 15 percent during the month but were 63 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 42 percent from last month but were 125 percent above 1987.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from July but were 1 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 18 percent during the month and were 6 percent below 1987. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 10 percent from last month but was the same as last year.

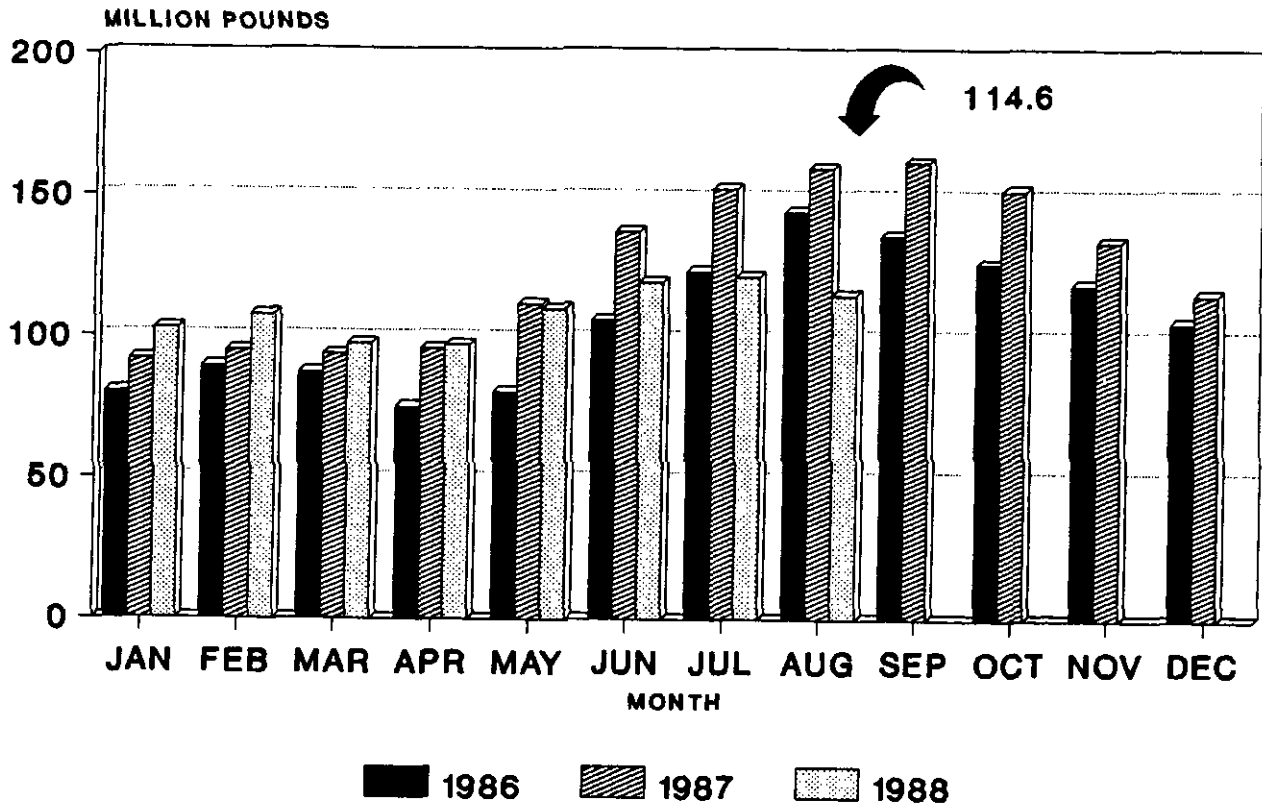

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 57 percent of capacity, 2 points below July. Public freezer occupancy at 65 percent was 1 point above last month but 4 points below last year.
