COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1988

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, pork, frozen eggs, potatoes, fruits, and beef, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, evaporated and condensed milk, dried and evaporated fruits, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from August and were 23 percent more than those on September 30, 1987. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month but were 55 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 31 percent from last month but were 133 percent above 1987.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from August 31 but were 10 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 4 percent during the month but were 9 percent below 1987. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 2 percent from last month but down 11 percent from last year.

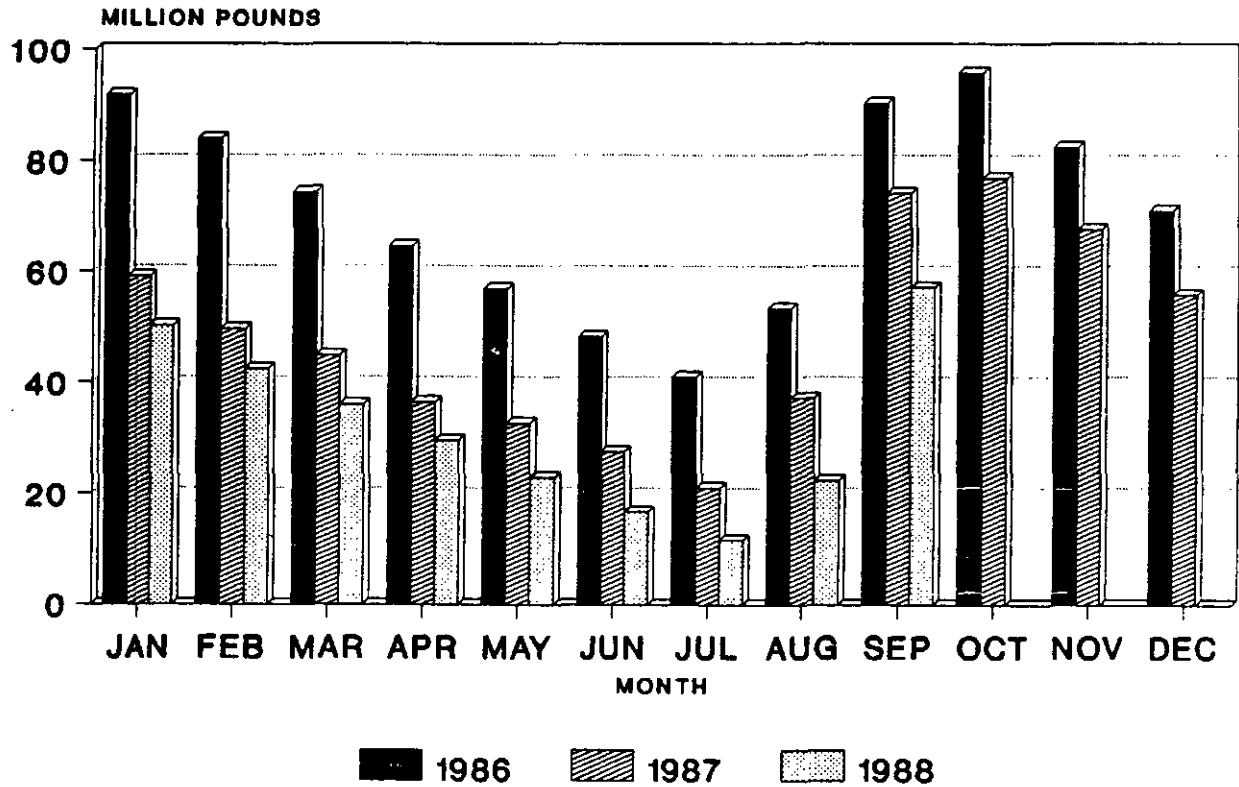

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 55 percent of capacity, 1 point below August 31. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was 3 points above last month but 5 points below last year.
