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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 1989 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, pork, juice concentrates, frozen eggs, and frozen fruits, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included dried and evaporated fruits, and fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers increased 4 percent from December 1988 and were 12 percent more than those on January 31, 1988. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month and were 30 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were the same as December, but were 80 percent above January 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 1 percent from December, 1988 but were 7 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 3 percent during the month and were 15 percent below January 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 3 percent from last month but down 2 percent from last year.

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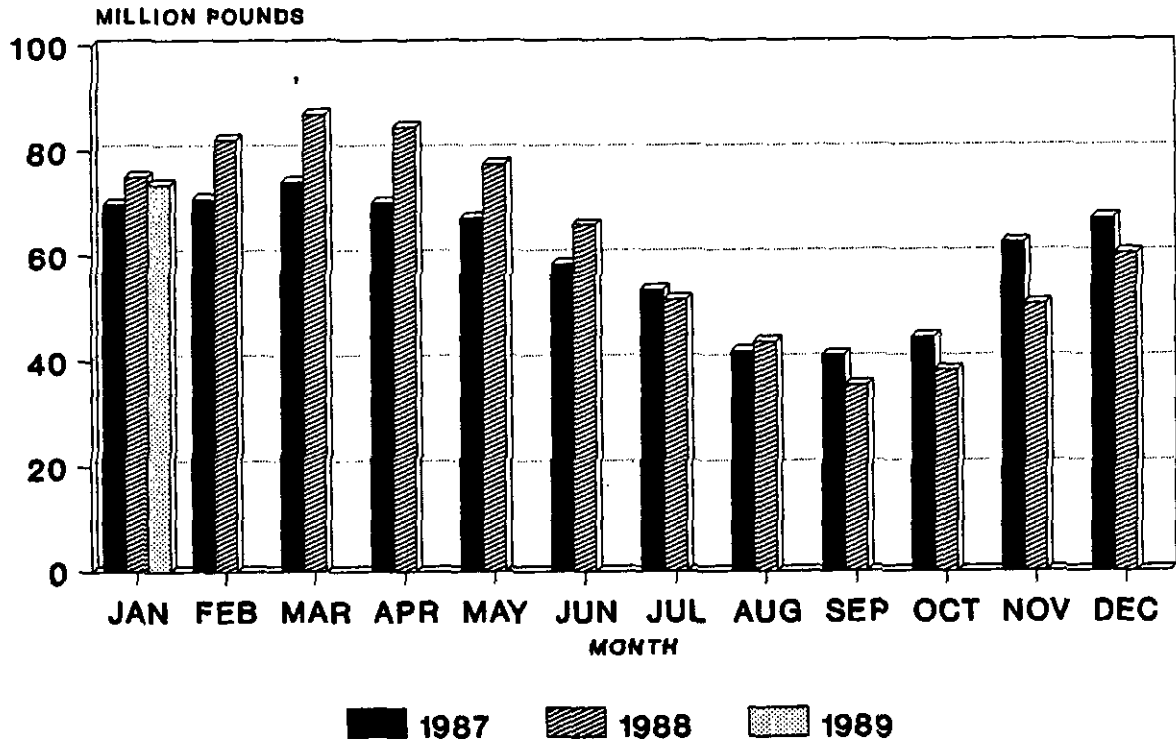

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 52 percent of capacity, 7 points below December, 1988. Public freezer occupancy at 65 percent was 1 point below last month and 2 points below last year.
