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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MARCH 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31, 1989 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, pork, frozen fruits, and frozen eggs, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included dried and evaporated fruits, and fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers decreased 2 percent from February but were 5 percent more than those on March 31, 1988. Frozen pork stocks rose less than 1 percent during the month but were 15 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 9 percent from last month and were 48 percent above 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased less than 1 percent from February but were 21 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens declined 2 percent during the month and were 23 percent below 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 2 percent from last month but down 21 percent from last year.

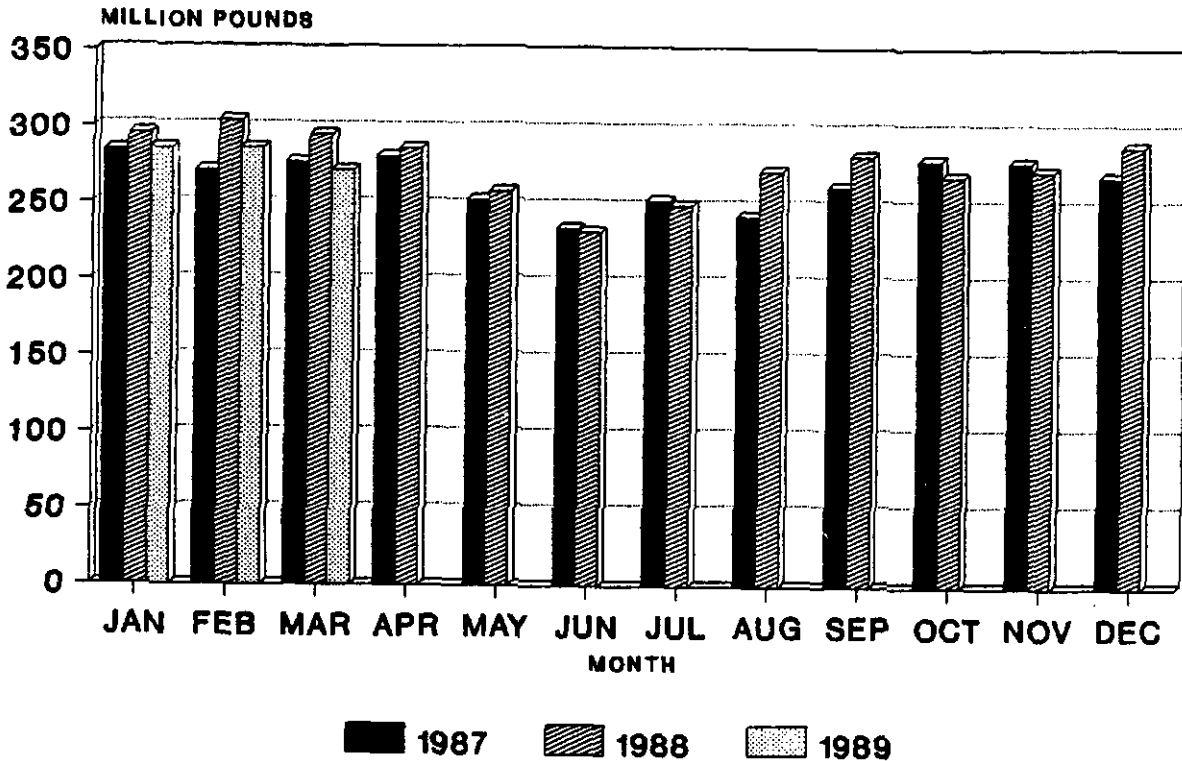

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 51 percent of capacity, 2 points below February. Public freezer occupancy at 61 percent was 3 points below last month and 4 points below last year.
