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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31, 1989 were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, pork, frozen fruits, and frozen potatoes, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included dried and evaporated fruits, shell eggs, fresh vegetables, and fresh fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from April 30 but were 2 percent more than those on May 31, 1988. Frozen pork stocks dropped 1 percent during the month but were 11 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 1 percent from last month but were 29 percent above 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 14 percent from April 30 but were 12 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month but were 10 percent below 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 19 percent from last month but down 13 percent from last year.

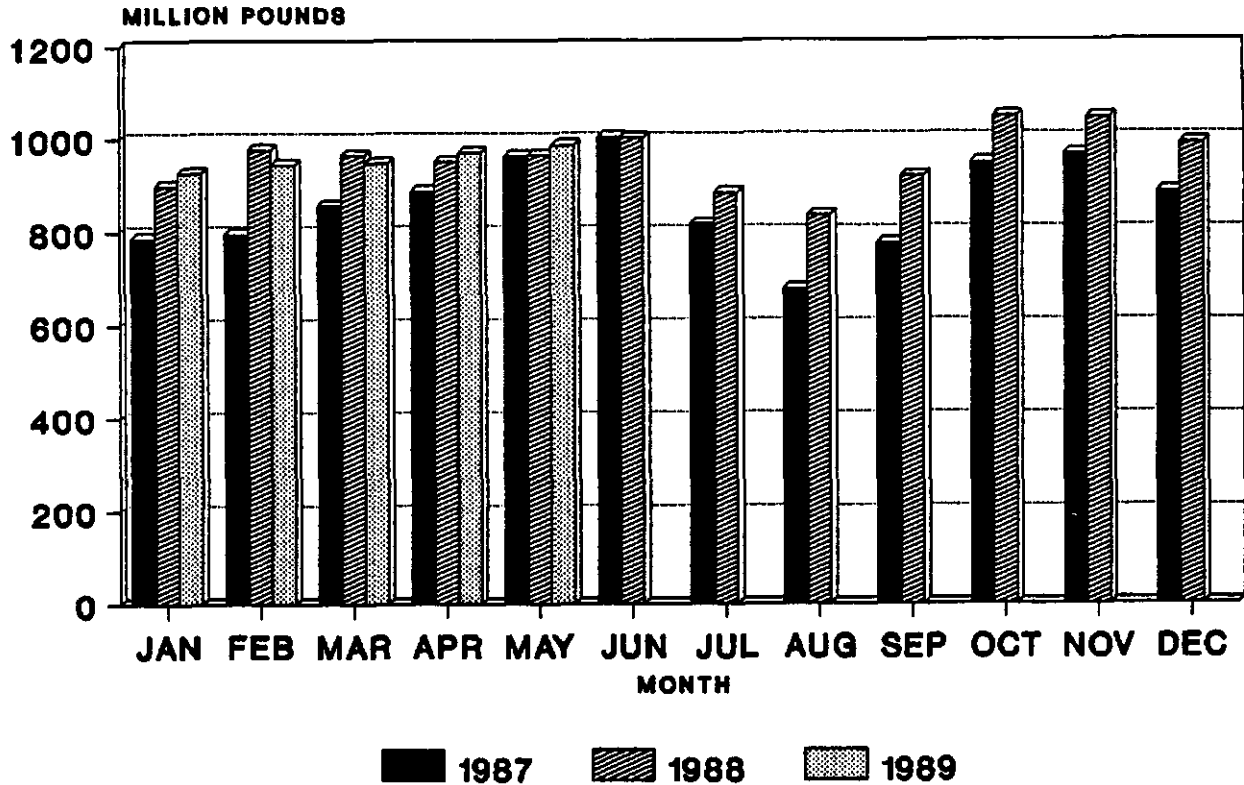

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 53 percent of capacity, 1 point above April 30. Public freezer occupancy at 61 percent was 1 point above last month but 1 point below last year.
