## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30, 1989 were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, and pork according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh fruits, fresh vegetables, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 7 percent from May but were 2 percent more than those on June 30, 1988. Frozen pork stocks dropped 11 percent during the month but were 6 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 10 percent from last month but were 25 percent above 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 19 percent from May but were 2 percent below last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 3 percent during the month but were 6 percent below 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 27 percent from last month but down 1 percent from last year.

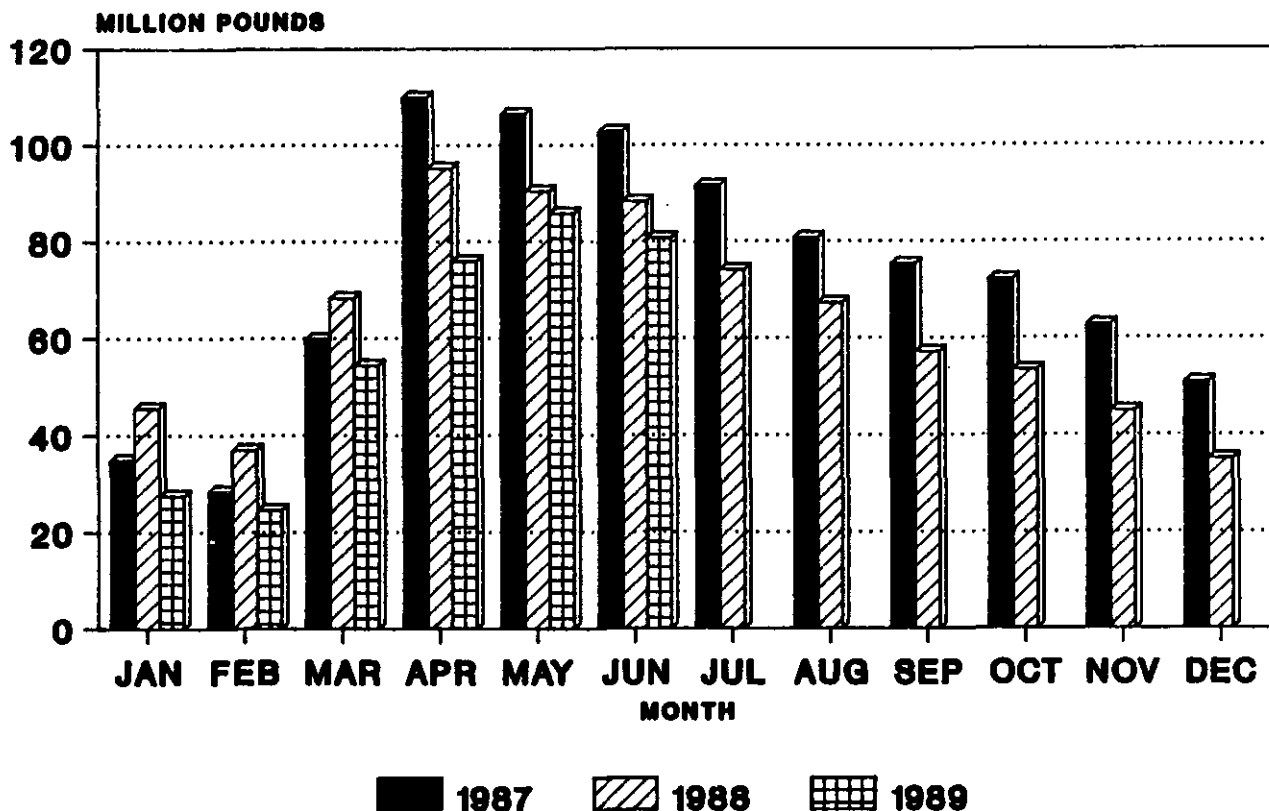

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was at 54 percent of capacity, 1 point above May, but 5 points below 1988. Public freezer occupancy at 62 percent was 1 point above last month but the same as last year.
