COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JULY 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31, 1989 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, pork, and turkeys, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from June 30 and were 2 percent less than those on July 31, 1988. Frozen pork stocks dropped 9 percent during the month but were 3 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 25 percent from last month but were 31 percent above 1988.

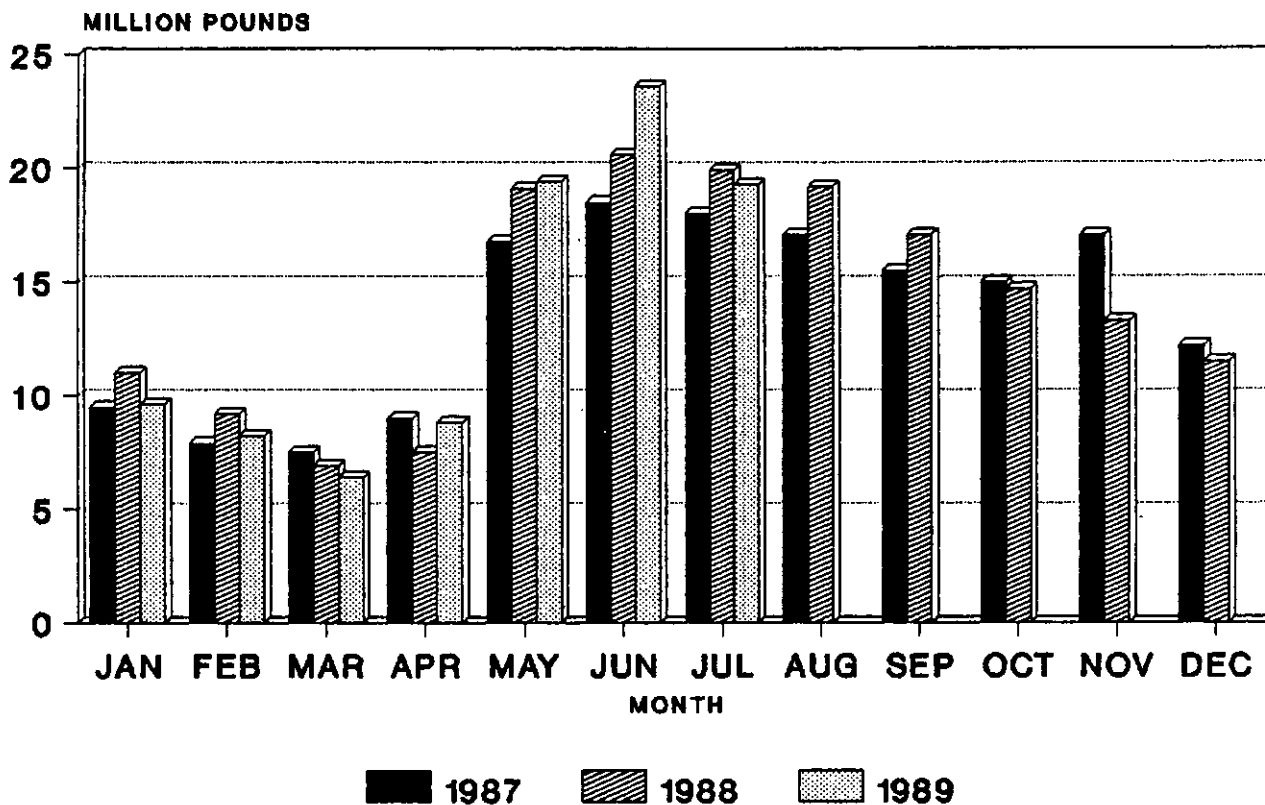
