## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, AUGUST 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on August 31 were greater than year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, chickens, and turkeys, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above the previous year included fresh fruits, dried and evaporated fruits, and fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers declined 12 percent from July 31 and were 9 percent less than a year ago. Frozen pork supplies dropped 19 percent during the month and were 2 percent below 1988. Stocks of pork bellies were down 48 percent from last month but were 17 percent above 1988.

Total frozen poultry increased 12 percent from July 31 and was 4 percent above last year. Total frozen chicken advanced 3 percent during August and was 5 percent above 1988. Total frozen turkey was up 15 percent from last month and up 4 percent from last year.

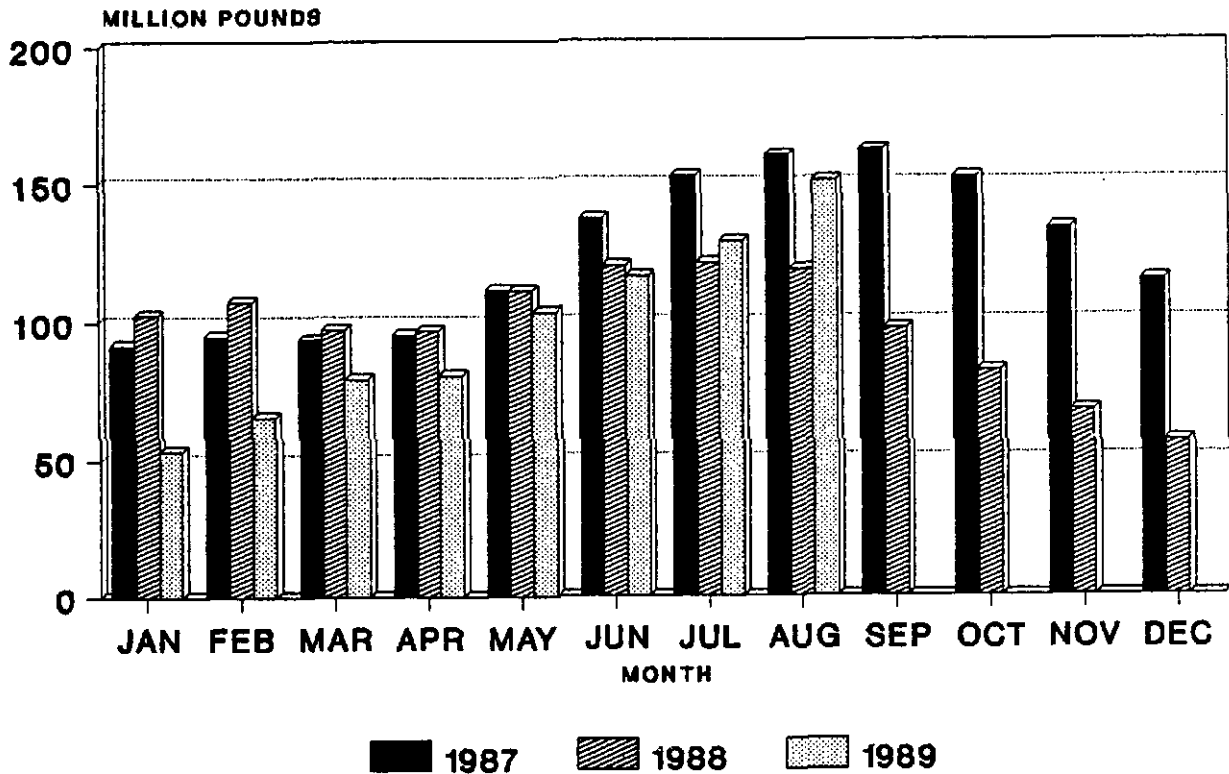
