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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, SEPTEMBER 30, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on September 30 were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, juice concentrates, chickens, vegetables, and turkeys, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 3 percent from August 31 and were 13 percent less than those on September 30, 1988. Frozen pork supplies remained almost the same during the month but were 2 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 34 percent from last month but were 6 percent above 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 3 percent from August 31 and were 4 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 12 percent during the month and were 14 percent above 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 1 percent from last month and up 1 percent from last year.

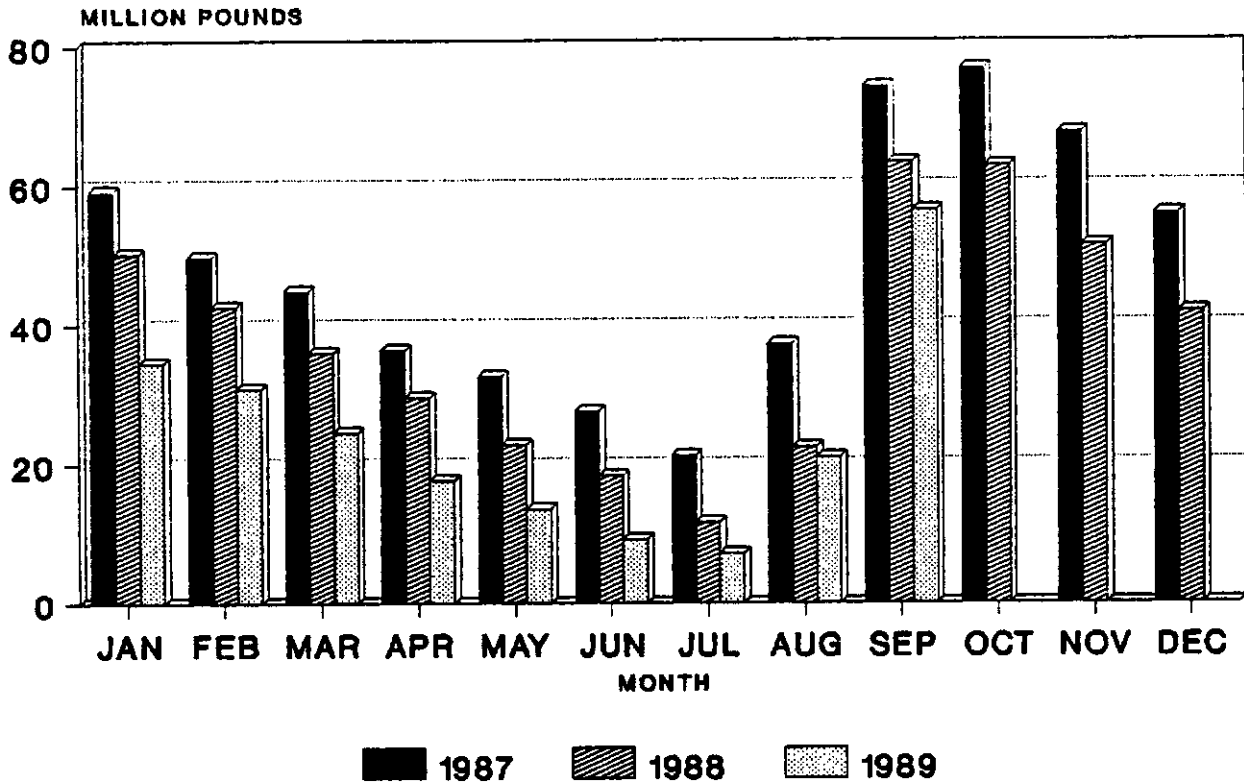

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 46 percent of capacity, 2 points below August and 9 points below last year. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was 3 points above last month and 1 point above last year.
