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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, OCTOBER 31, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on October 31, 1989 were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, frozen vegetables, chicken, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, and dried and evaporated fruits.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from September 1989 and were 19 percent less than those on October 31, 1988. Frozen pork supplies dropped 3 percent during the month and were 15 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 22 percent from last month but were 19 percent below 1988.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from September 30 but were nearly the same as last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month and were 6 percent above 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 1 percent from last month but down 2 percent from last year.

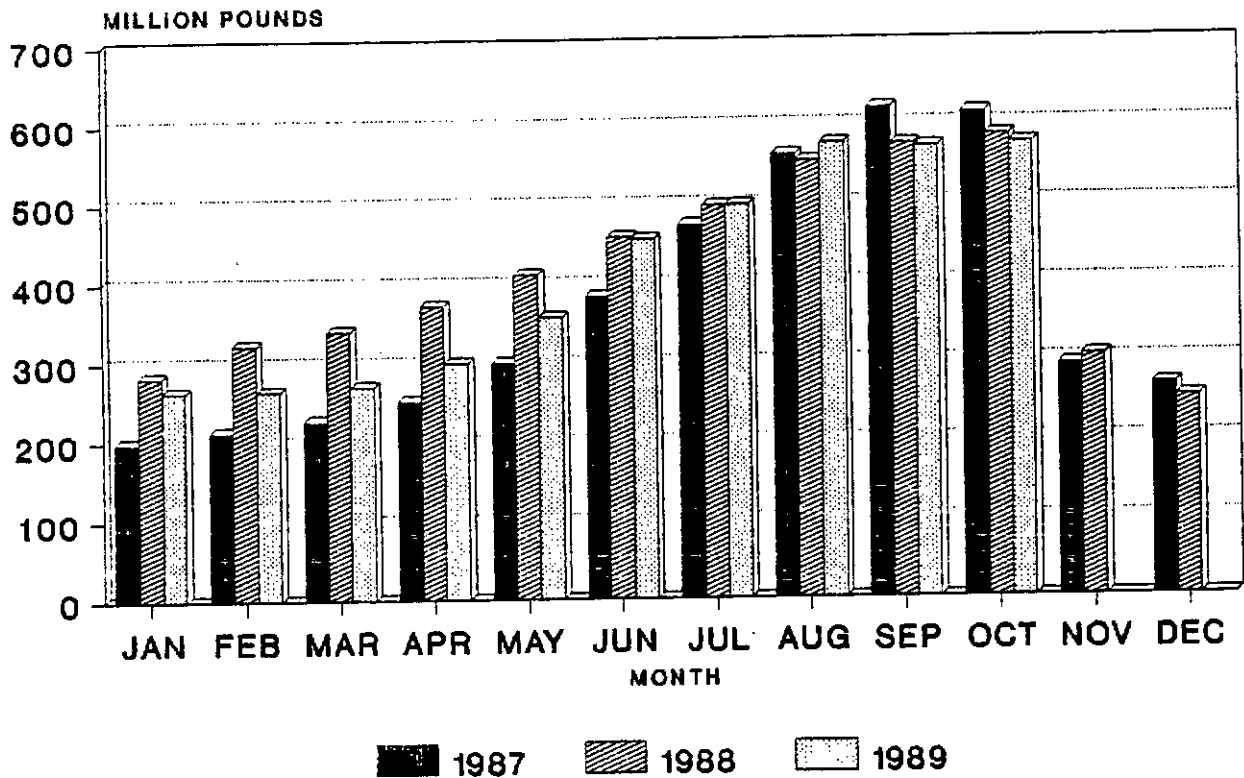

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 48 % of capacity, 1 point above September 30 . Public freezer occupancy at 73 percent was 4 points above last month and 7 points above last year.
