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## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, NOVEMBER 30, 1989

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on November 30, were greater than year earlier levels for butter, vegetables, chickens, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. The only cooler item with stocks above the previous year was fresh vegetables.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from October 31 but were 22 percent less than those on November 30, 1988. Frozen pork stocks rose 2 percent during the month but were 22 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 72 percent from last month but were 26 percent below 1988.

Total frozen poultry decreased 38 percent from October 31 and was 5 percent below last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 11 percent during the month and were 11 percent above 1988. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were down 55 percent from last month and down 15 percent from last year.

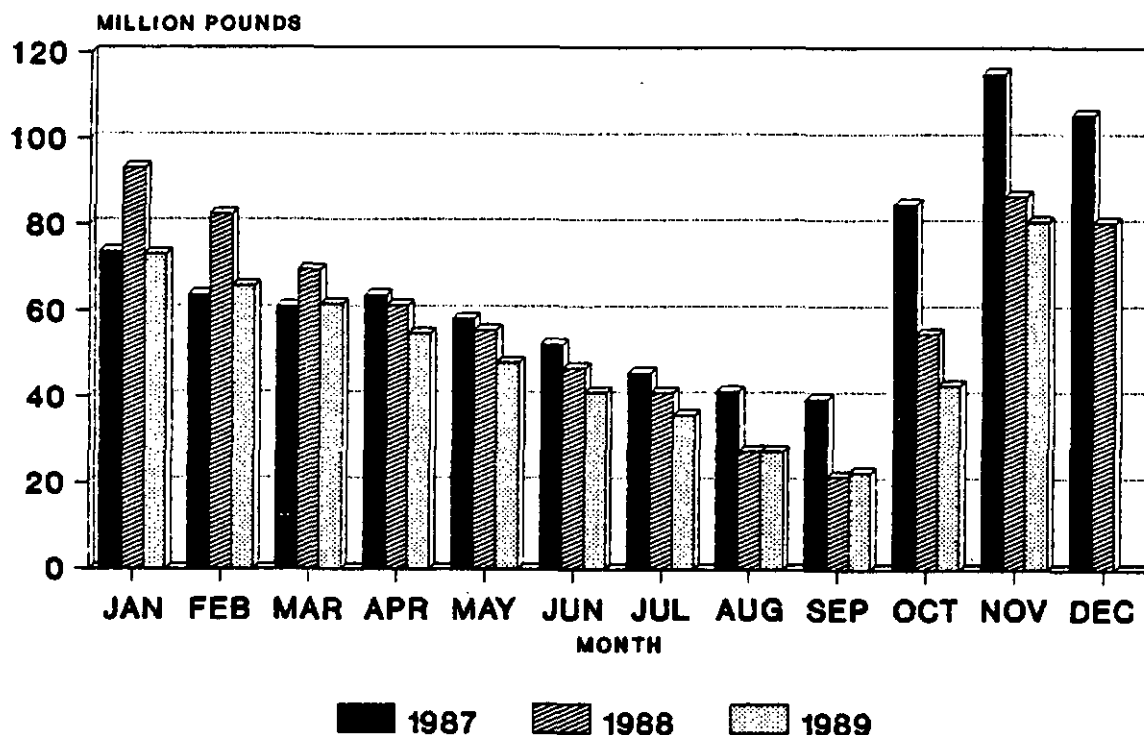

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was at 50 percent of capacity, 2 points above October 31. Public freezer occupancy at 70 percent was 3 points below last month but 1 point above last year.
