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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JANUARY 31, 1990

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for chickens, vegetables, butter, and turkeys according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs, fresh vegetables, and nuts.

Total red meats in freezers advanced 7 percent from December, 1989 but were 23 percent less than those on January 31, 1989. Frozen pork stocks advanced 8 percent during the month but were 27 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 7 percent from last month and were 32 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry increased 9 percent from December and was 10 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 5 percent during the month and were 25 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 13 percent from last month and 2 percent above last year.

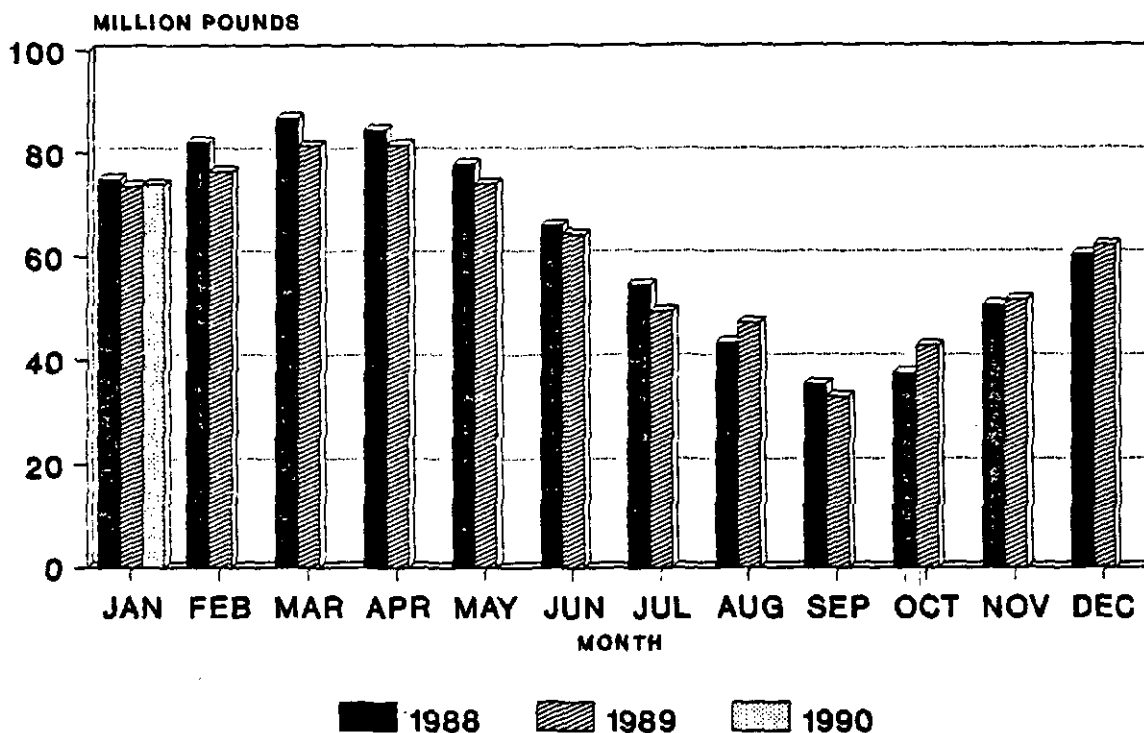

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 48 percent of capacity, 1 point below December, 1989. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was the same as last month but 2 points above last year.
