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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, FEBRUARY 28, 1990

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for chickens, vegetables, potatoes, and turkeys according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included shell eggs and nuts other than peanuts and pecans.

Total red meats in freezers increased 8 percent from January 31, 1990 but were 20 percent less than those on February 28, 1989. Frozen pork stocks rose 13 percent during the month but were 22 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 11 percent from last month but were 29 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from January and were 13 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 2 percent during the month and were 30 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers were up 2 percent from last month and up 3 percent from last year.

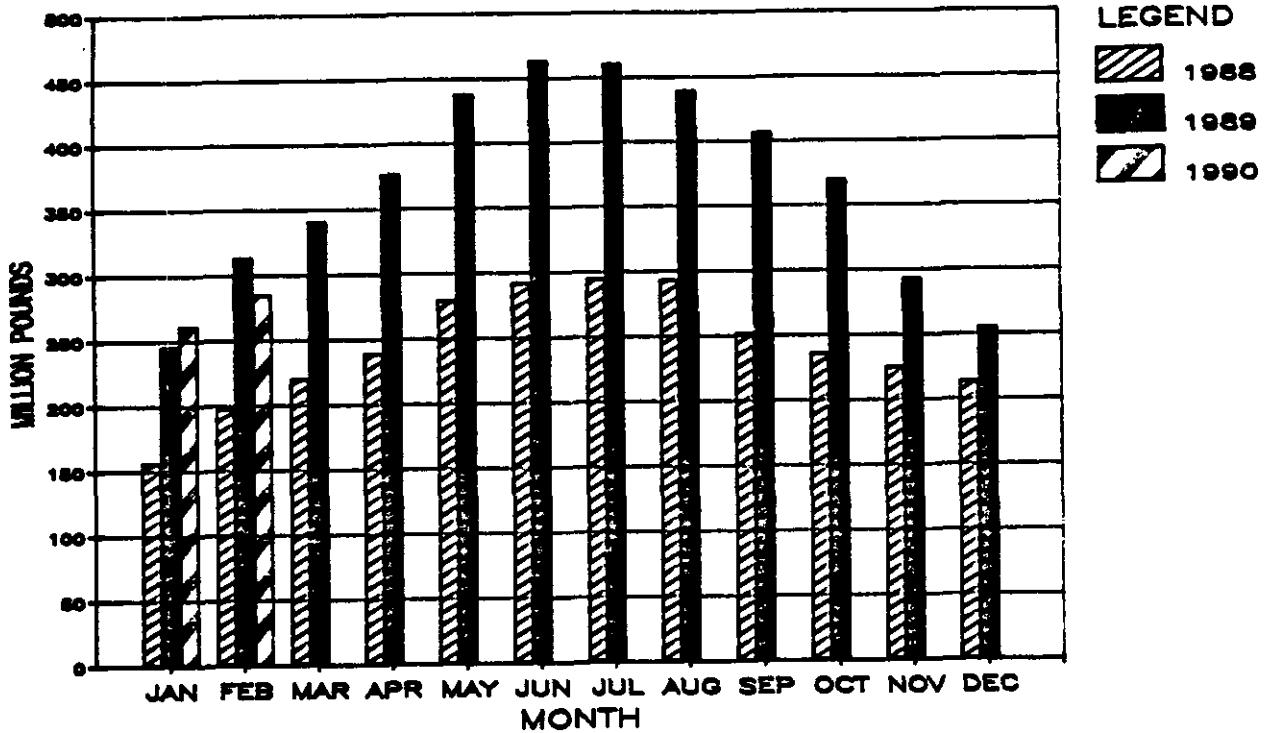

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 49 percent of capacity, 2 points above January. Public freezer occupancy at 66 percent remained the same as last month but 2 points above last year.
