COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, APRIL 30, 1990

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for chicken, vegetables, turkeys, eggs, potatoes, and beef, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included peanuts and other nuts in shell, pears, and American cheese.

Total red meats in freezers increased 2 percent from last month but were 14 percent less than those on hand April 30, 1989. Frozen pork stocks rose 8 percent during the month but were 26 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 5 percent from last month but were 29 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 7 percent from a month ago and were 27 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 3 percent during the month and were 44 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkeys in freezers was up 11 percent from last month and up 18 percent from last year.

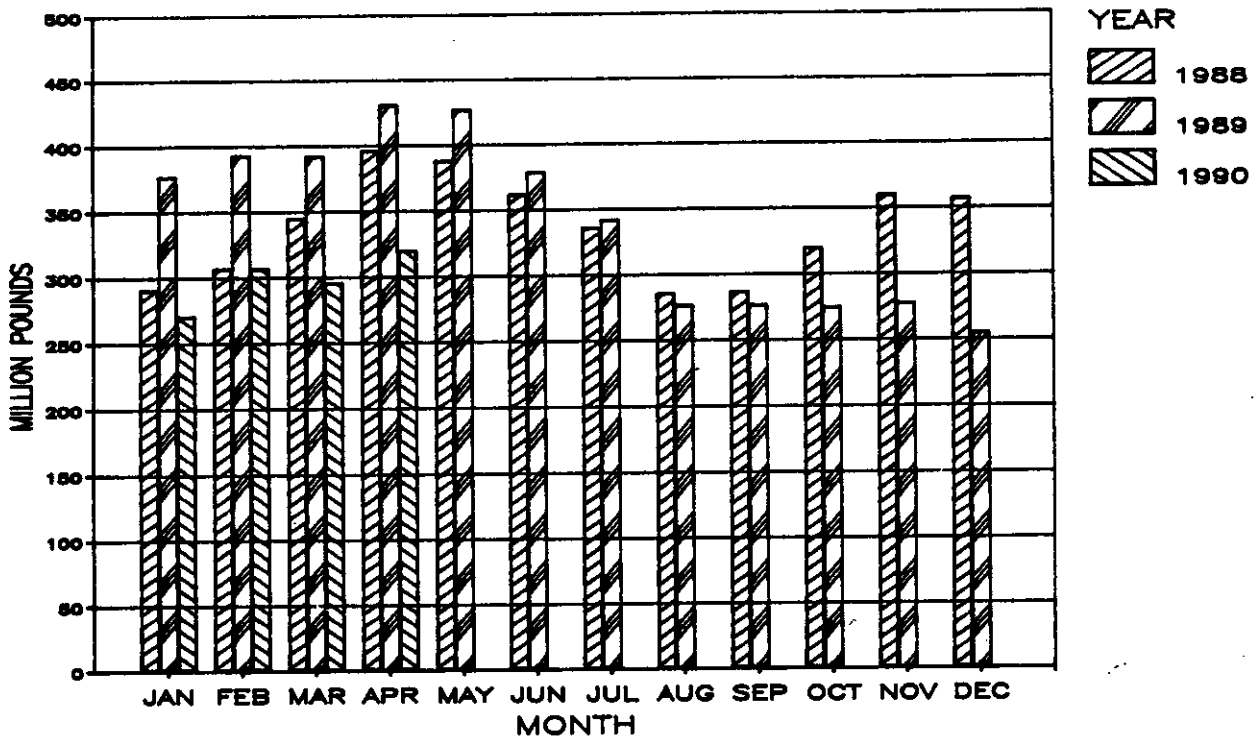

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 53 percent of capacity, 1 point above March 31, 1990. Public freezer occupancy at 64 percent was 2 points below last month but 3 points above last year.
