## COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, MAY 31, 1990

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for chicken, vegetables, turkey, fruit, beef, potatoes, and eggs, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables and cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 4 percent from last month and were 14 percent less than those on hand May 31, 1989. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month but were 25 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 2 percent from last month but were 26 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 9 percent from a month ago and were 23 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 1 percent during the month and was 42 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers was up 15 percent from both last month and last year.

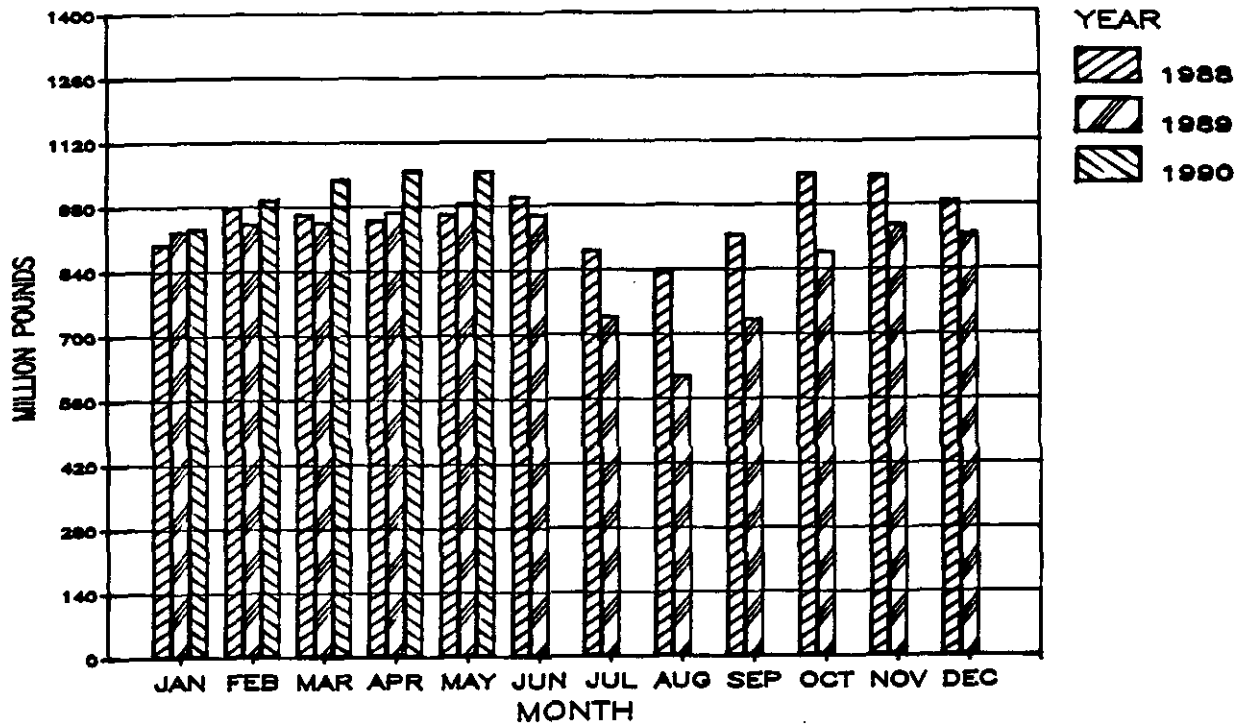

**OCCUPANCY:** Public cooler occupancy was at 53 percent of capacity, 1 point below last month. Public freezer occupancy at 63 percent was 1 point below last month but 2 points above last year.
