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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS, JUNE 30, 1990

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on June 30, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for vegetables, chicken, eggs, fruit, beef, turkeys, and potatoes, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included vegetables, dried and evaporated fruit, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 6 percent from last month and were 13 percent less than those on hand June 30, 1989. Frozen pork stocks dropped 9 percent during the month and were 23 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 16 percent from last month and were 30 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 12 percent from May and were 13 percent above last year. Total stocks of chickens advanced 1 percent during the month and were 34 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 19 percent from last month and up 6 percent from last year.

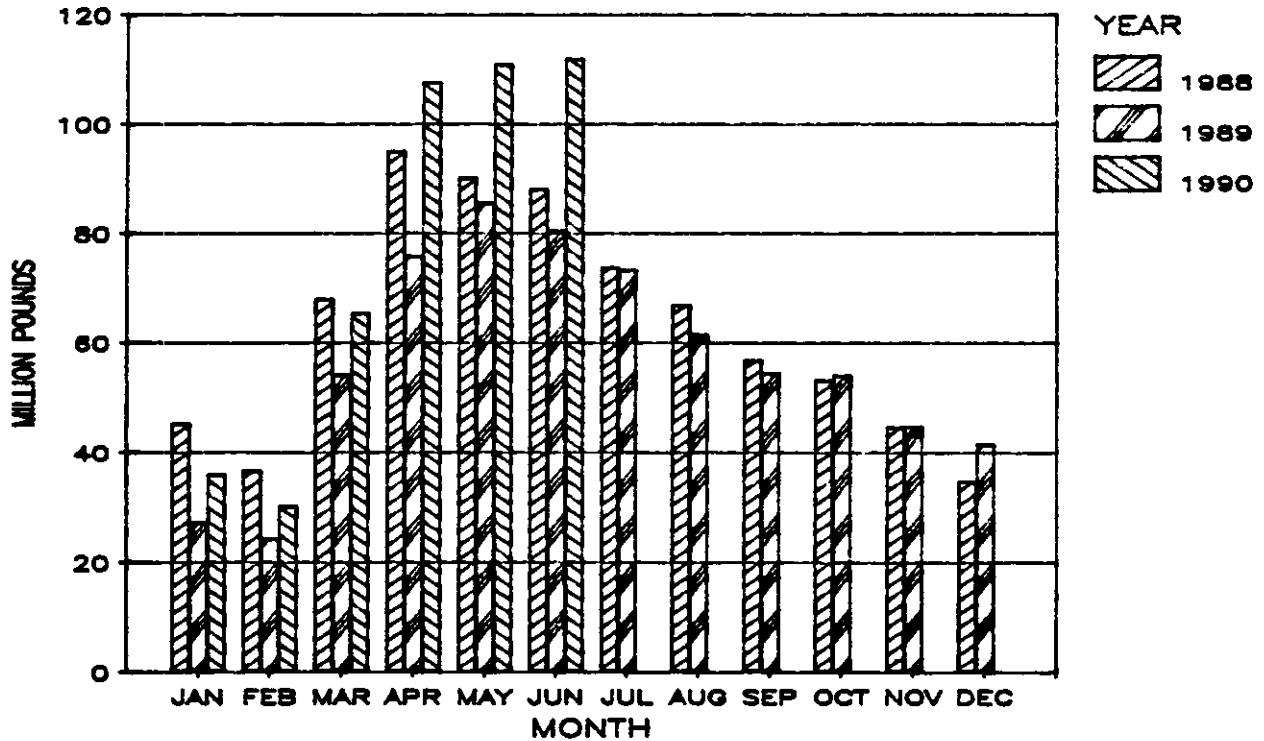
