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## HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on July 31, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for chicken, vegetables, fruit, turkey, beef, eggs, and potatoes, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included pears, dried and evaporated fruit, and natural cheese.

Total red meats in freezers declined 5 percent from June and were 14 percent less than those on hand July 1989. Frozen pork stocks dropped 13 percent during the month and were 25 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 36 percent from last month and were 40 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 5 percent from last month and were 17 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken declined 2 percent during the month but were 47 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 9 percent from last month and up 7 percent from last year.

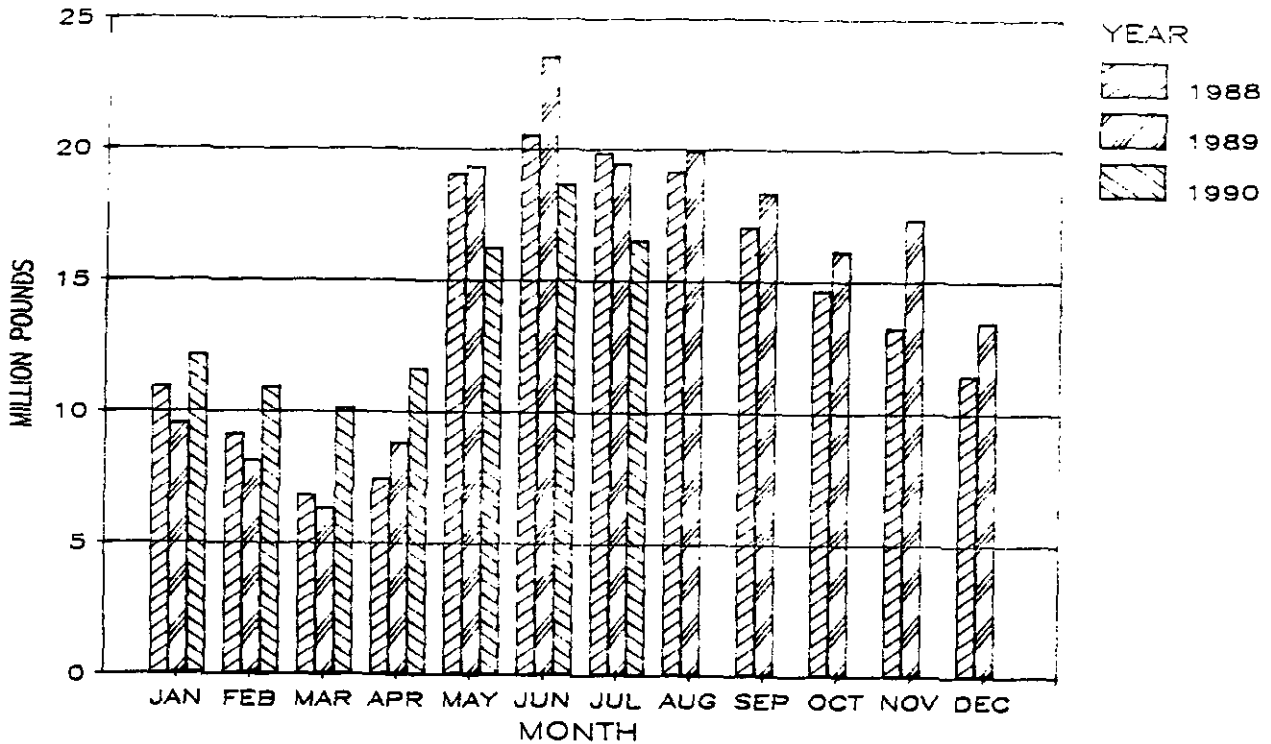
