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HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on October 31, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for beef, chicken, vegetables, potatoes, eggs, butter, turkey, and juice concentrates, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, natural cheese, fresh fruit, and dried and evaporated fruit.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 7 percent from last month and were 1 percent more than those on hand October 1989. Frozen pork stocks rose 5 percent during the month but were 14 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 15 percent from last month but were 86 percent below 1989.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 2 percent from September 1990 and were 12 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 4 percent during the month and were 19 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 1 percent from last month and up 9 percent from last year.

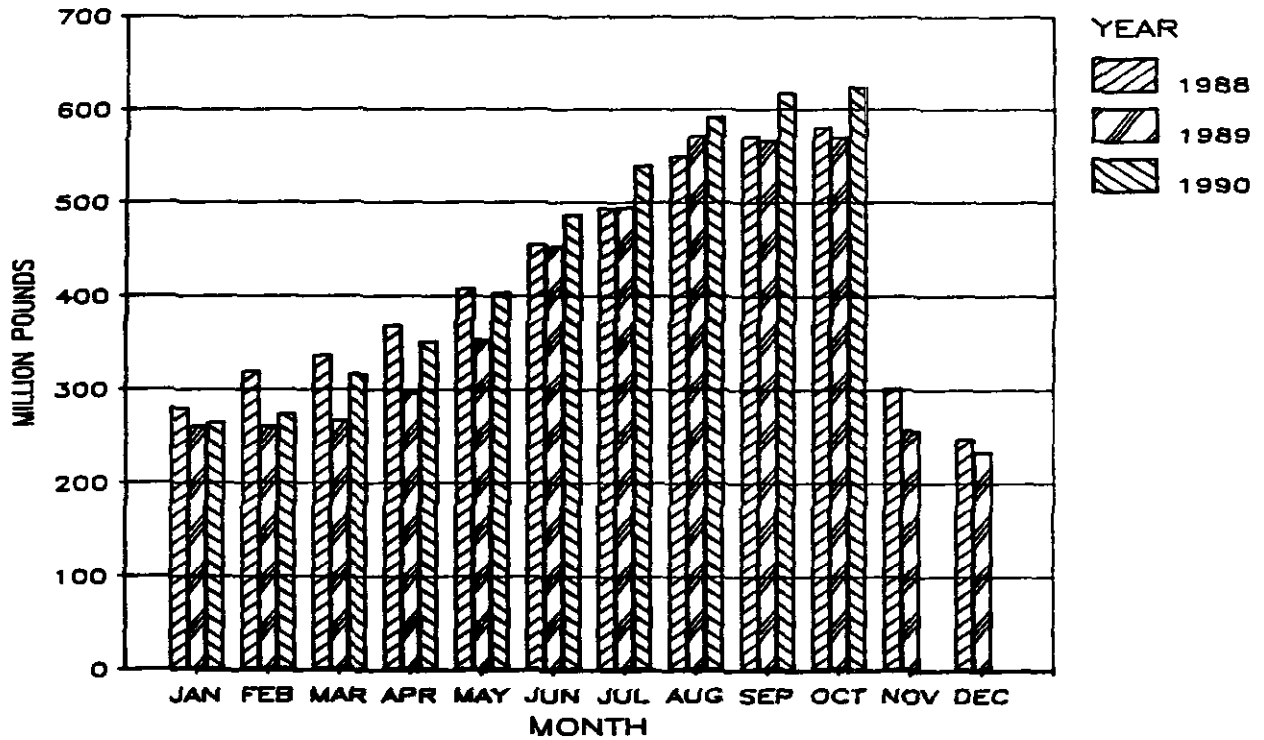
