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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on December 31, 1990 were greater than the year earlier levels for all major product groups except pork, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, natural cheese and apples.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 7 percent from last month and were 7 percent more than those on hand December 31, 1989. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month but were 8 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 96 percent from last month but were 44 percent below 1989.

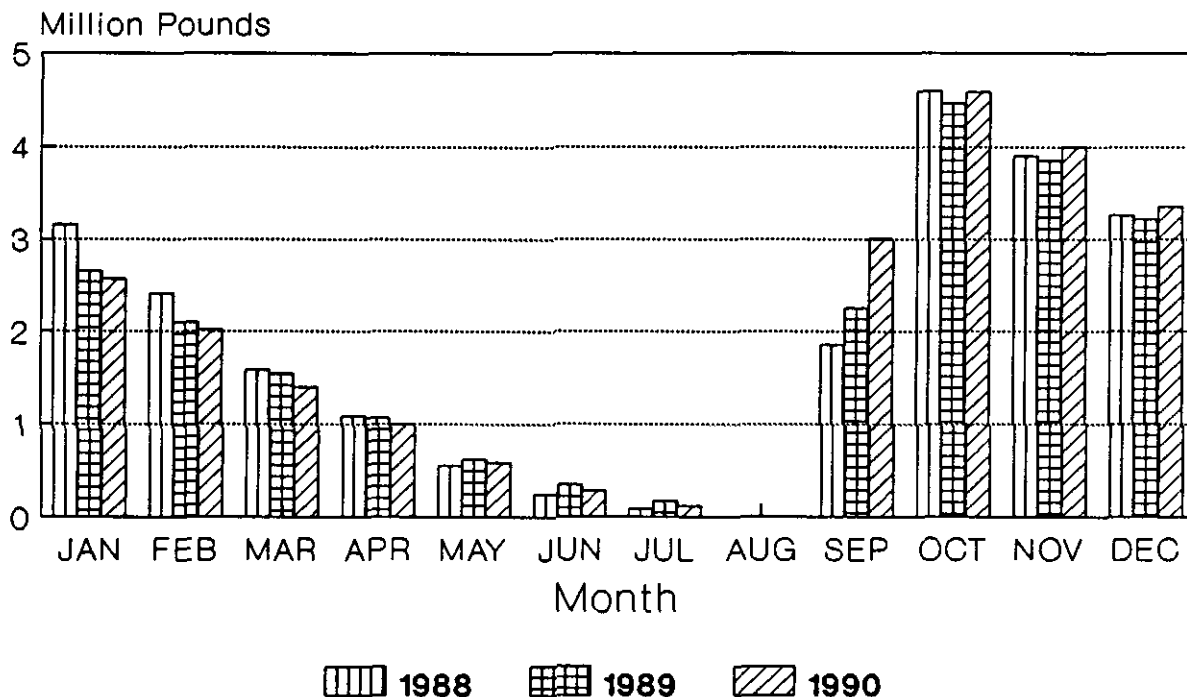

FRESH APPLES

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 3 percent from November 1990 but were 21 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 6 percent during the month and were 11 percent above 1989. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were down 8 percent from last month but up 31 percent from last year.

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 52 percent of capacity, the same as last month. Public freezer occupancy at 72 percent was 1 point below last month but 5 points above last year.
