COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 1991, were greater than a year earlier levels for all major product categories, with butter, juice concentrates, vegetables, and poultry showing the largest increases, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included natural cheese, fresh vegetables, and apples.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 4 percent from last month and were 5 percent more than those on hand January 31, 1990. Frozen pork stocks rose 6 percent during the month but were 9 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 4 percent from last month but were 37 percent below 1990.

Total frozen poultry supplies decreased 2 percent from December 1990 but were 9 percent above last year. Total chicken stocks declined 2 percent during the month but were 6 percent above 1990. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were down 2 percent from last month but up 12 percent from last year.

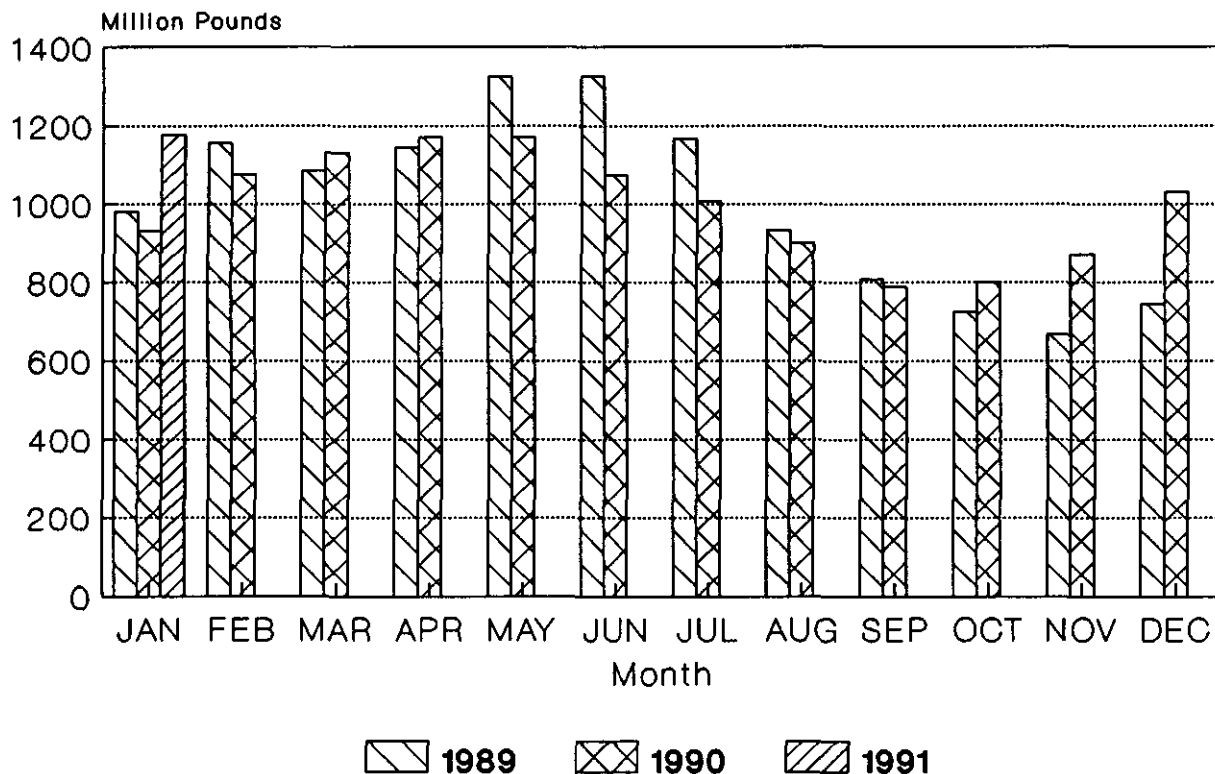

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 52 percent of capacity, the same as last month. Public freezer occupancy at 69 percent was 3 points below last month but 3 points above last year.

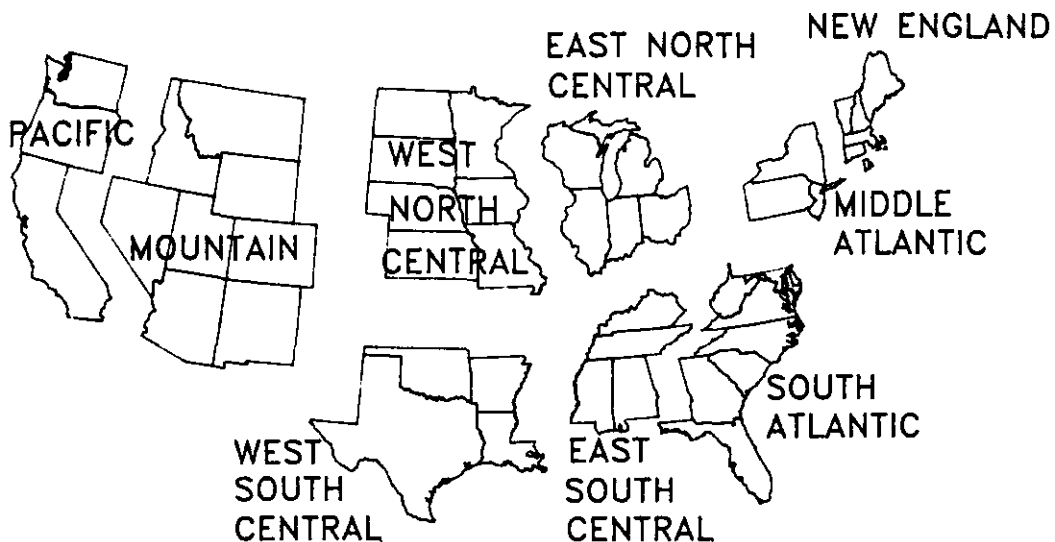
