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COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on February 28, 1991, were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, turkeys, vegetables, juice concentrates, chicken, and beef, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, natural cheese, and fresh fruit.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 4 percent from last month but were up slightly from those on hand February 28, 1990. Frozen pork stocks rose 18 percent during the month but were 4 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 12 percent from last month but were 36 percent below 1990.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 10 percent from January 1991 and were 17 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 7 percent during the month and were 10 percent above 1990. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 14 percent from last month and up 24 percent from last year.

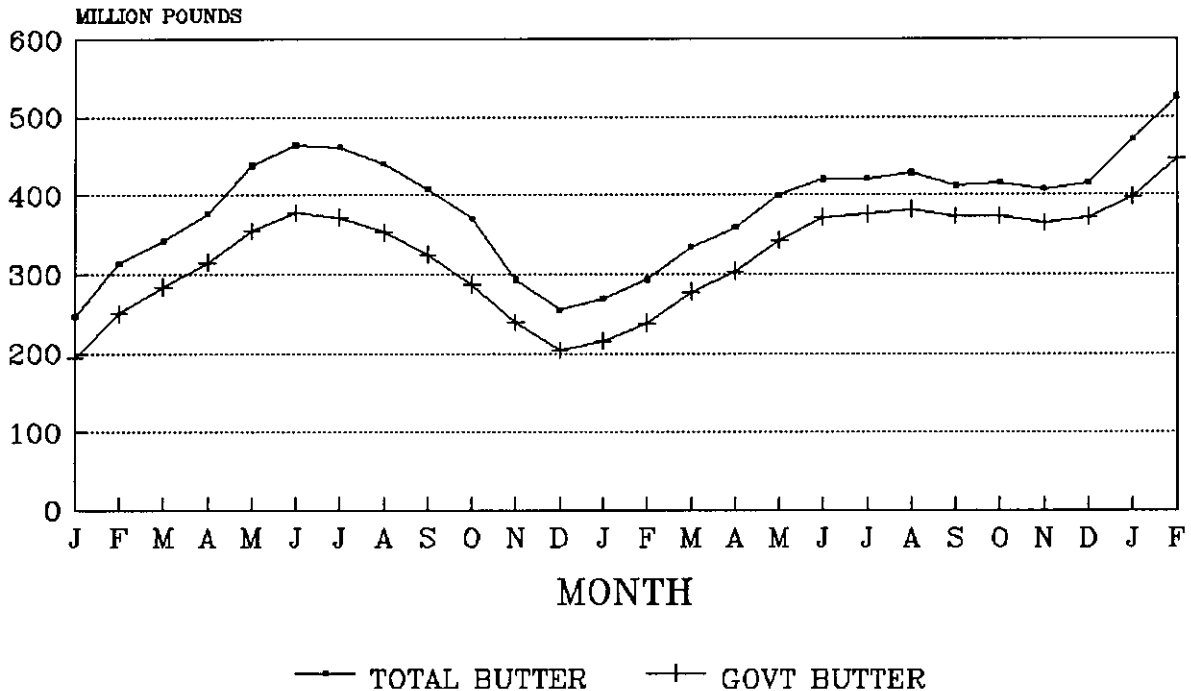

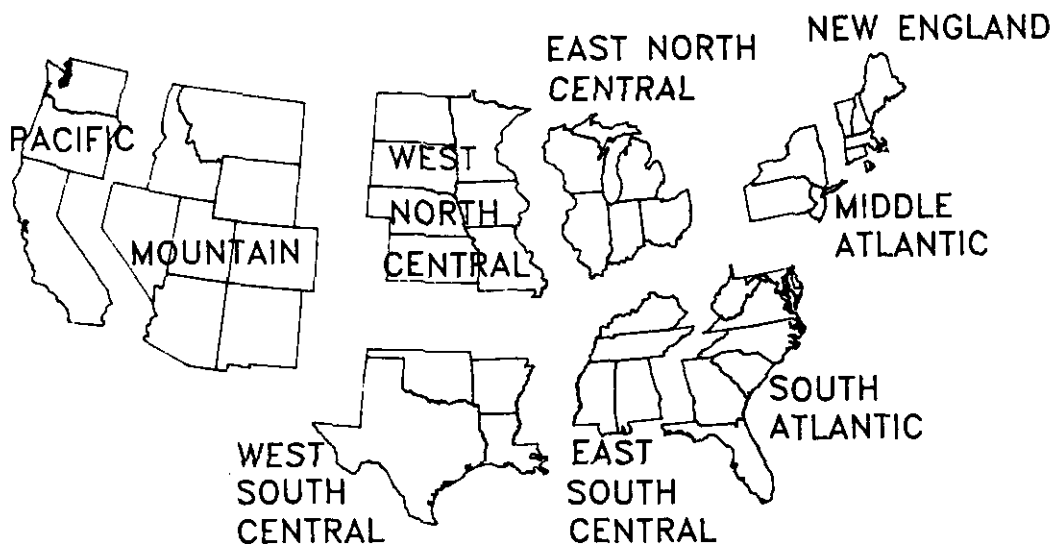
