COLD STORAGE HIGHLIGHTS

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on March 31, 1991, were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, vegetables, juice concentrates, poultry, and fruits, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included evaporated and condensed milk, fresh vegetables, natural cheese, and apples.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 1 percent from last month but were 5 percent less than those on hand a year ago. Frozen pork stocks rose 1 percent during the month but were 3 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 25 percent from last month but were 30 percent below 1990.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 4 percent from February and were 11 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 1 percent during the month and were 8 percent above 1990. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 7 percent from last month and up 14 percent from last year.

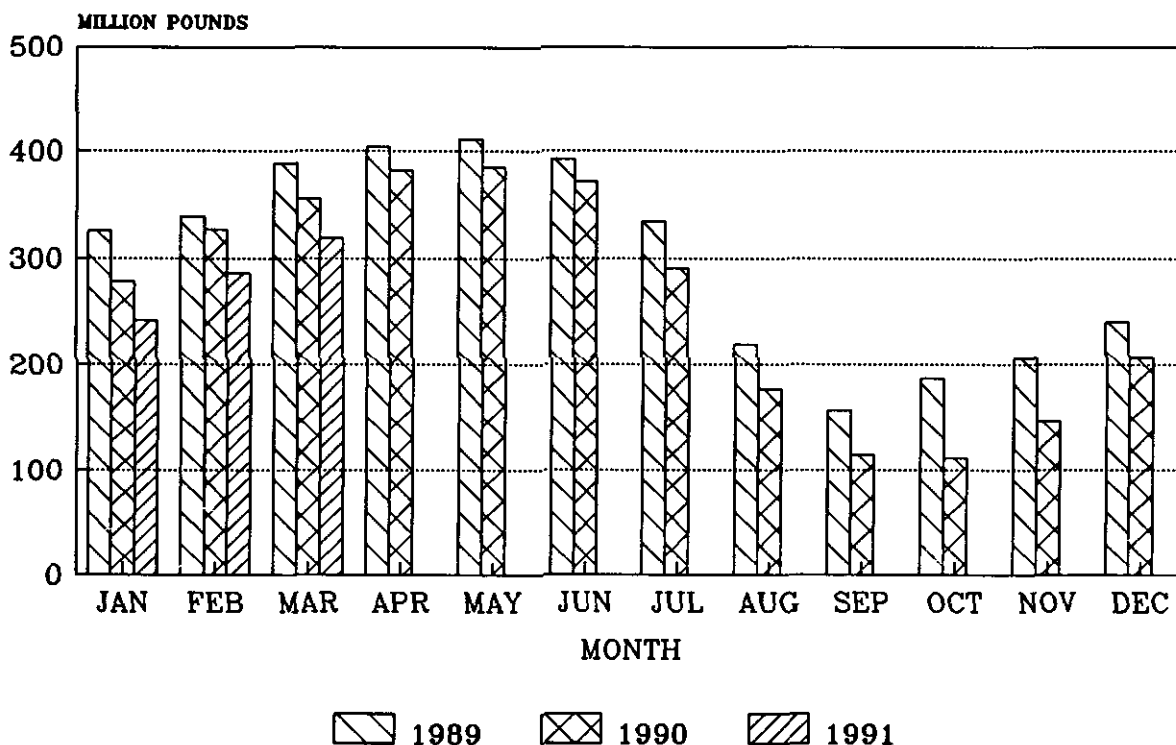

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 53 percent of capacity, the same as last month. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was also unchanged from last month but was 2 points above last year.

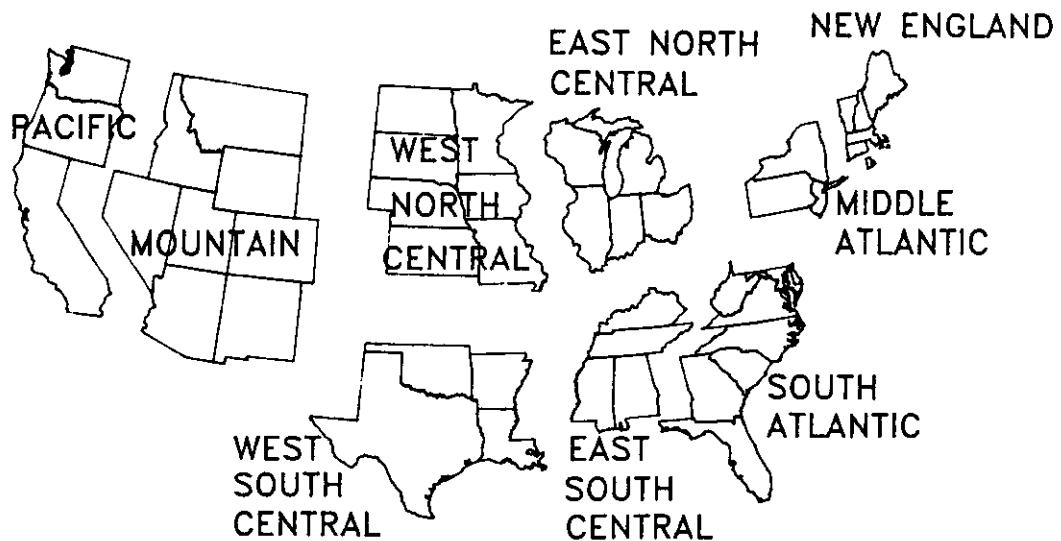
