Released May 24, 1991, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Estimates refer to April 30, 1991.

Frozen stocks in refrigerated warehouses on April 30, 1991, were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, concentrated juices, vegetables, poultry, and pork. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included fresh vegetables, apples, and natural cheese.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 6 percent from last month but were 2 percent less than those on hand a year ago. Frozen pork stocks rose 16 percent during the month and were 5 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were up 18 percent from last month but were 22 percent below 1990.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 8 percent from March and were 11 percent above last year. Total stocks of chicken advanced 5 percent during the month and were 6 percent above 1990. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 11 percent from last month and up 15 percent from last year.

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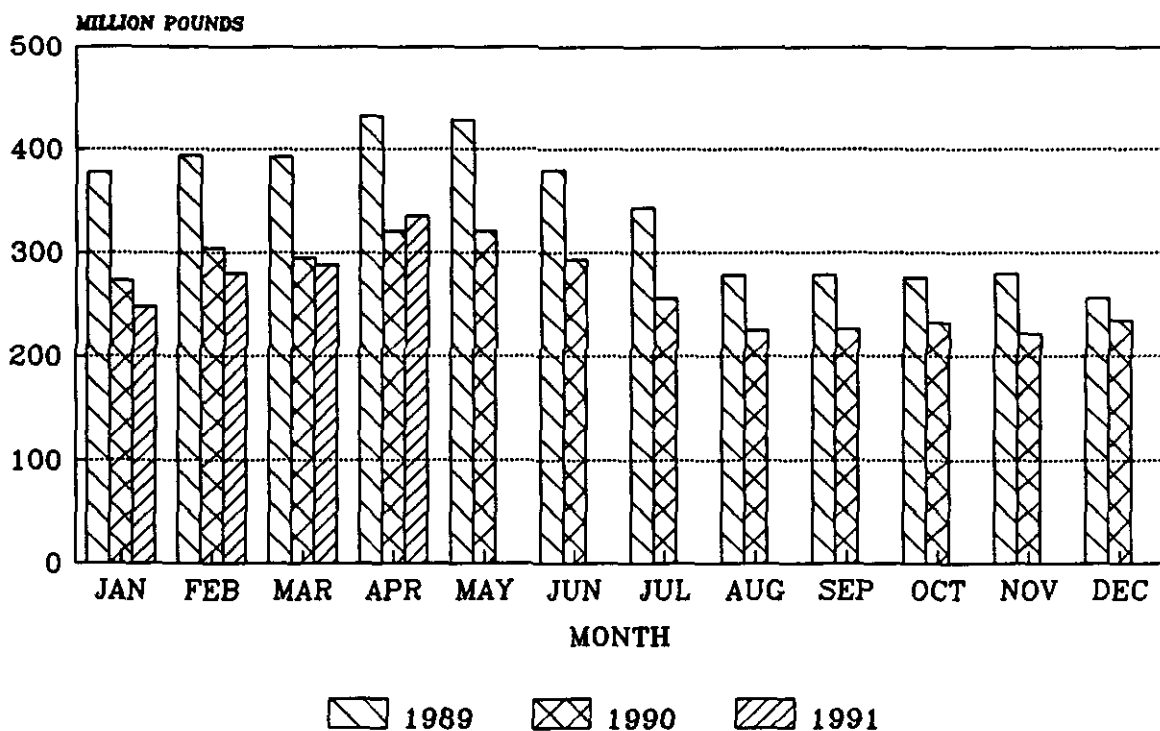

OCCUPANCY: Public cooler occupancy was at 48 percent of capacity, down 5 points from last month. Public freezer occupancy at 68 percent was unchanged from last month but was 4 points above last year.

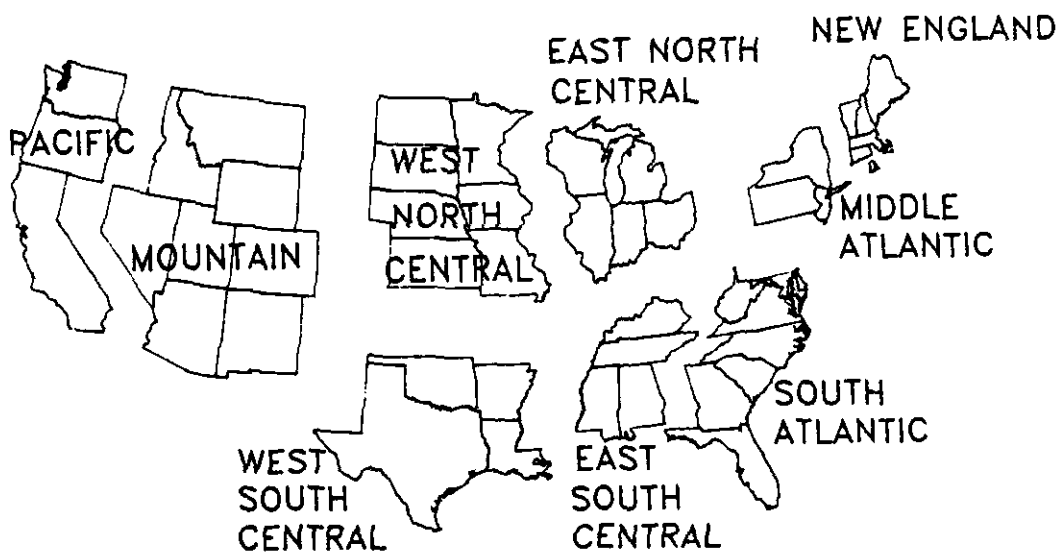
