Butter Stocks Reach Record High

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on May 31, 1991, were greater than the year earlier levels for butter, frozen fruit juices, poultry, vegetables, potatoes, and pork. Butter stocks, at 642 million pounds, reached a record high due to record high government butter holdings. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included natural cheese and apples.

Total red meat supplies in freezers declined 5 percent from last month and were 2 percent less than those on hand a year ago. Frozen pork stocks dropped 1 percent during the month but were 5 percent above the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were practically the same as last month but were 24 percent below May 1990.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 9 percent from April 1991 and were 12 percent above last year's level. Total stocks of chicken advanced 6 percent during the month and were 15 percent above 1990. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 10 percent from both last month and last year.

Public cooler occupancy was at 52 percent of capacity, 4 points above last month. Public freezer occupancy at 67 percent was 1 point below last month but 4 points above last year.

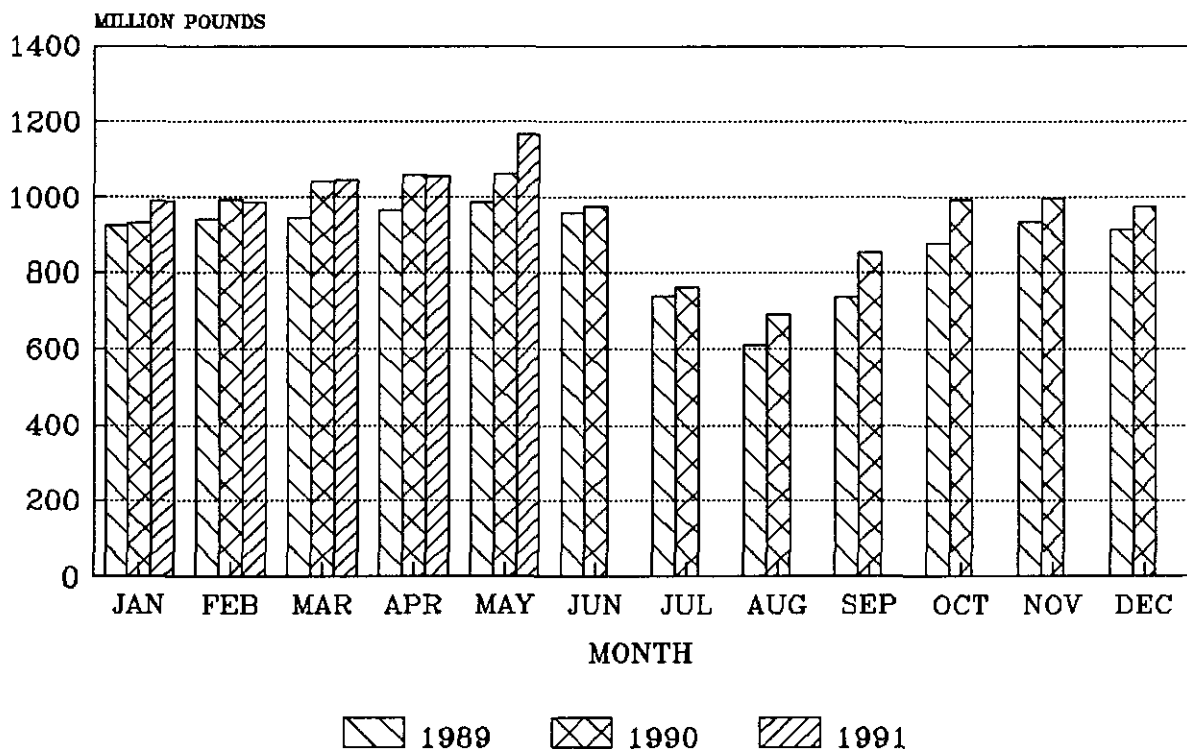
