Released February 22, 1993, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Estimates refer to January 31, 1993.

Frozen food stocks in refrigerated warehouses on January 31, 1993, were greater than the year earlier levels for chicken, fruit, pork, vegetables, and fruit juice. Cooler items with stocks above those of the previous year included apples and natural cheese.

Total red meat supplies in freezers increased 4 percent from last month but were 9 percent less than those on hand January 1992. Frozen pork stocks increased 4 percent during the month but were 4 percent below the previous year. Stocks of pork bellies were down 8 percent from last month and were 16 percent below 1992.

Total frozen poultry supplies increased 4 percent from both last month and last year. Total stocks of chicken declined slightly during the month but were 17 percent above 1992. Total pounds of turkey in freezers were up 16 percent from last month but down 4 percent from last year.

Public cooler occupancy was at 58 percent of capacity, 1 point below January 1992. Public freezer occupancy at 64 percent was 1 point below both last month and a year ago.

Pork Breakdown Changes

In response to requests from the pork industry, the National Agricultural Statistics Service is now collecting data for boneless hams and loins, butts, and variety meats. These new data series start with the January 1993 data presented in this report. Note the definitions below.

Hams, boneless: Includes full hams, bone removed, and individual muscles separated. These were previously combined with bone-in hams.

Loins, boneless: Includes pork tenderloins. These were previously combined with bone-in loins.

Butts: Were formerly included in "other" pork.

Trimnings: Includes 42% regular trimmings, 72% special trimmings, boneless picnic meat, jowls, neckbone trimmings, and blade, cheek, head, and ham shank meat, etc.

Other: Includes ears, tails, feet, neckbones, and snouts.

Variety Meats: Includes tongues, kidneys, livers, stomachs, chitterlings, hearts, and salivary glands. Were formerly included in "other" pork.

Unclassified: Pork unable to be classified in any of the above categories.

Note: Packaged bacon and sausage and processed items such as hot dogs and luncheon meat are included under miscellaneous cooler or freezer.

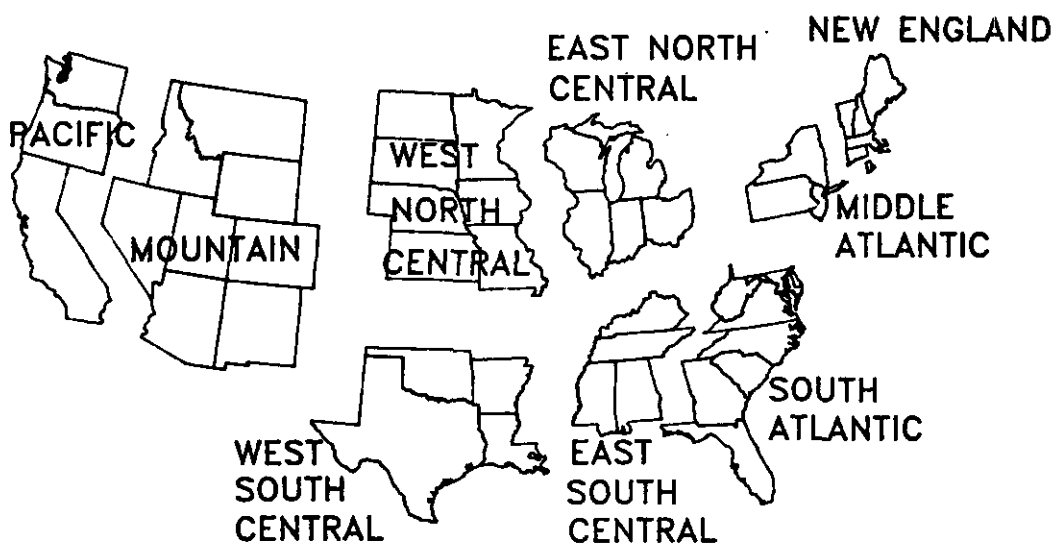

Survey procedures: Questionnaires are mailed about the 24th of each month to all operators on the list of approximately 1,650 public and private cold storage warehouses. In addition, apple data are obtained from special surveys and other sources (State Departments of Agriculture, American Apple Institute, etc.). All survey data represent stocks as of the end of the month.

Data are collected from warehouses artificially cooled to a temperature of 50 degrees Fahrenheit or lower, and whose food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. All food items in these facilities are reported regardless of the number of days stored at the time of the report. Also included are specialized storage facilities meeting the 30 day requirement, such as fruit houses, dairy manufacturing plants, frozen fruit, fruit juice, and vegetable processors, and poultry and meat packing plants. Excluded are stocks in space maintained by wholesalers, jobbers, distributors, chain stores, locker plants containing individual lockers, meat packer branch houses, and frozen food processors whose entire inventories are turned over more than once a month.

Estimating procedures: Data for reporting firms are added to estimates for non-reporting firms to obtain regional and National totals. Estimates for non-reporting firms are obtained by multiplying the previous month's figure by a percent change from the previous month. The percent change is calculated for each item from totals of the current and previous month summed from firms that reported both months.

Revision policy: Data are revised the following month based on late reports or corrected data. Final figures are published in the annual summary in February of the following year.

Reliability: Reports are received from 900 firms each month which represent about 70 percent of the total capacity. Firms that are not on the list or firms who have never reported are not represented in the data. Monthly data can vary due to different firms reporting month to month. Survey data are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions and mistakes in reporting and in processing the data. While these errors cannot be measured directly, they are minimized by carefully reviewing all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The next "Cold Storage" report will be released at 3:00 p.m. ET on March 22, 1993.

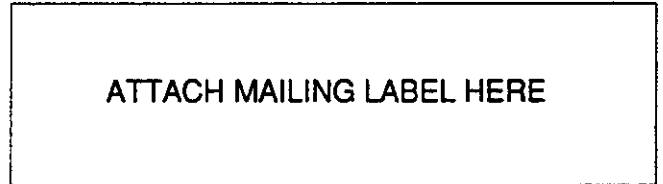
