Cotton consumed during the month ending July 31, 1992, amounted to 683,018 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of July was 666,850 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 2,883,711 bales. The number of active consuming cotton spindles was 3,703,000. The quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 332,200 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(92)-7", dated August 26, 1992.
