Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton Consumed during the month ending June 30, 1993, amounted to 959,551 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of June was 690,861 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 4,477,427 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles was 3,316,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 372,900 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(93)-06", dated July 28, 1993.
