Bureau of the Census Cotton Information

Cotton consumed during the month ending November 30, 1993, amounted to 729,146 bales. Cotton on hand in consuming establishments at the end of November was 576,170 bales, and the total in public storage and in compresses was 11,042,247 bales. Active consuming cotton spindles totaled 3,148,000, and the quantity of domestic cotton exported, excluding linters, was 385,100 bales. These and other data were published in "Census Bulletin M22P(93)-11", dated December 22, 1993.
